Publication Ukraine in figures, 2022 contains the main indicators of the social and economic situation in Ukraine in 2022 as compared with 2021, 2020 та 2019. Data for 2019–2021 exclude the temporarily occupied territories of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, the city of Sevastopol and part of the temporarily occupied territories in the Donetsk and Luhansk regions. Data for 2022 exclude the territories temporarily occupied by the Russian Federation and part of territories where combat actions are/were carried out.

Information for 2022 produced according to data from central bodies of executive power is compiled on the basis of available administrative data.

Information on individual general economic and sectoral indicators for 2022 will be made public after the deadline for submitting statistical and financial reports established by the Law of Ukraine "On the Protection of the Interests of Subjects of Reporting and Other Documents During Martial Law or a State of War".

Selected general economic and sector indicators for 2022 are preliminary and estimated and may be revised in the further editions.

The methodology for indicators compilation meets international and European standards, this ensures the possibility to compare them with other countries.

1. Political system and religions

Ukraine is a sovereign, independent, democratic, social and legal state.

Ukraine is a Republic. Ukraine's people represent the sovereignty and is the unified source of power in the country. People execute power directly as well as through state authorities and local self-administration offices.

State power in Ukraine is exercised on the basis of its legislative, executive and judicial branches.

Ukraine's Constitution has supreme judicial power.

The President of Ukraine is the Head of the State and speaks on behalf of its name¹. The President is elected by citizens of Ukraine on the basis of the common, equal and direct voting right by ballot for the period of five years and no more than for two terms successively.

The legislative branch consists of a one-chamber parliament – the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.

Executive power is carried out by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine.


Political parties and public organisations take active part in the creation of the democratic state. They are the source of innovation, and social and political technologies suggested to the society. They also act as guarantors of the democratic development of Ukraine.

Climate

The Eastern European Plain (95% of the area), together with the medium-altitude Ukrainian Carpathians and Crimean Mountains (5% of the area) have mainly a temperate continental climate. The Southern Crimea climate has subtropical features.

In 2022 the **absolute minimum** of air temperature was minus 23⁰ – in January in the Chernihiv oblast.

In 2022 the **absolute maximum** of air temperature was plus 38⁰ – in July-August in the Mykolayiv, Kherson oblast.









Gross value added structure for 2022 (percent)



Real GDP real GVA: Manufacturing Agriculture Transport Trade










Number of registered legal entities, by type of economic activity


Growth dynamics of the number of registered legal entities and the number of active

(units)




Share of active enterprises-legal entities in the total number of registered legal entities of RSO

(percent)




Share of active enterprises by types of economic activity (percent)

(as of November 1, 2022; percent)







Structure of industrial production sold in 2020 (percent)







(percent)










Increase, decrease (-) in livestock products, 2022














