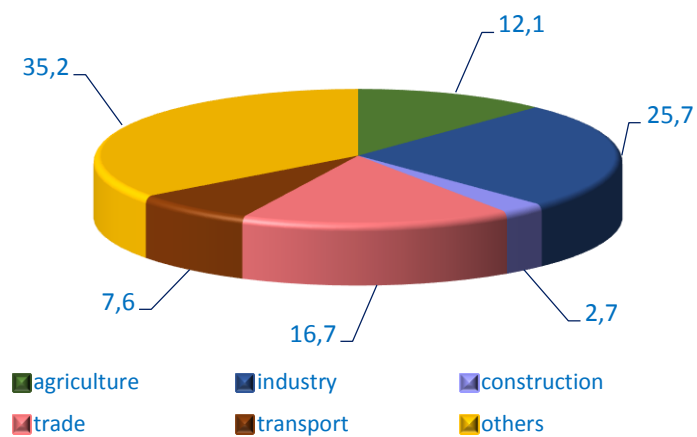

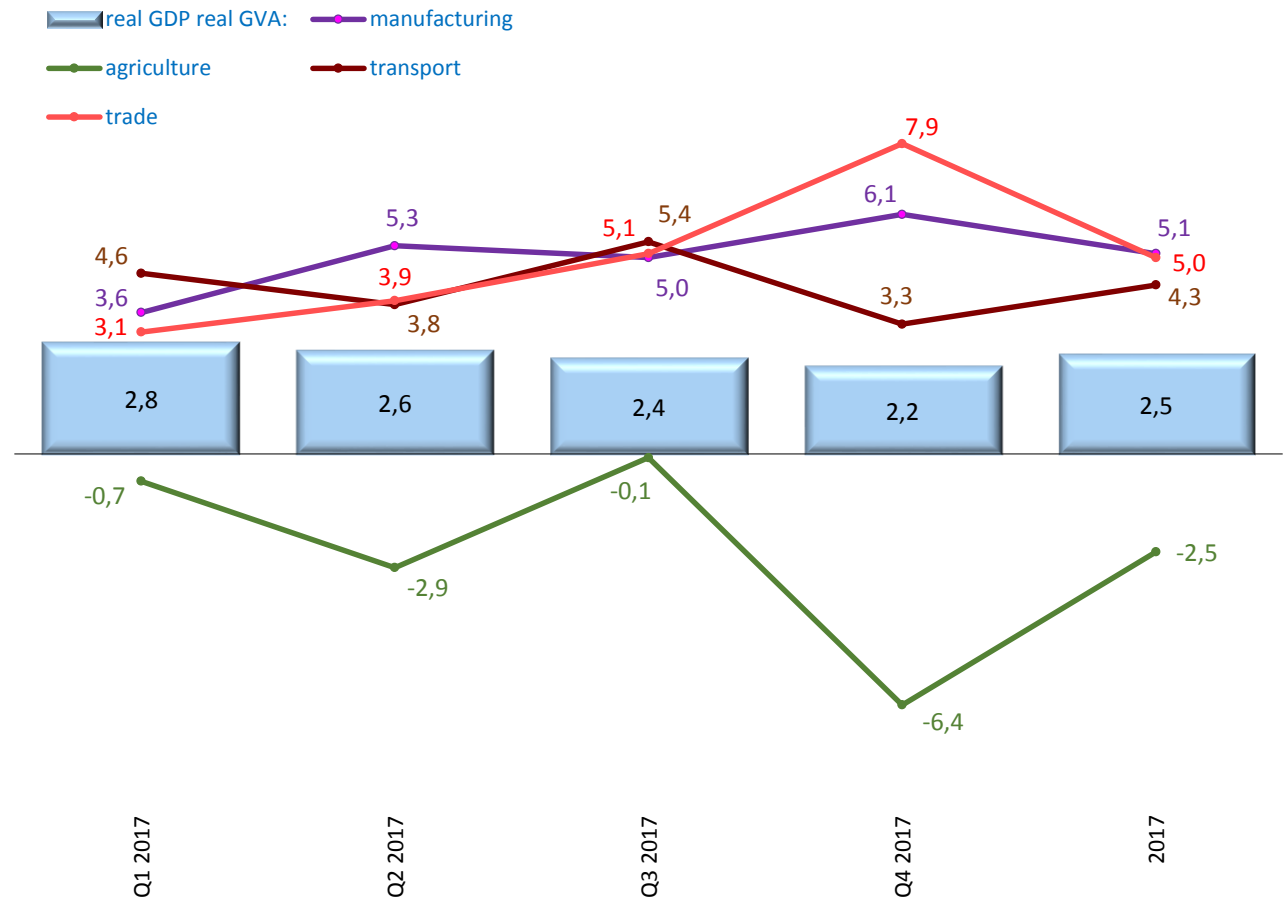
Gross value added structure for 2017, %

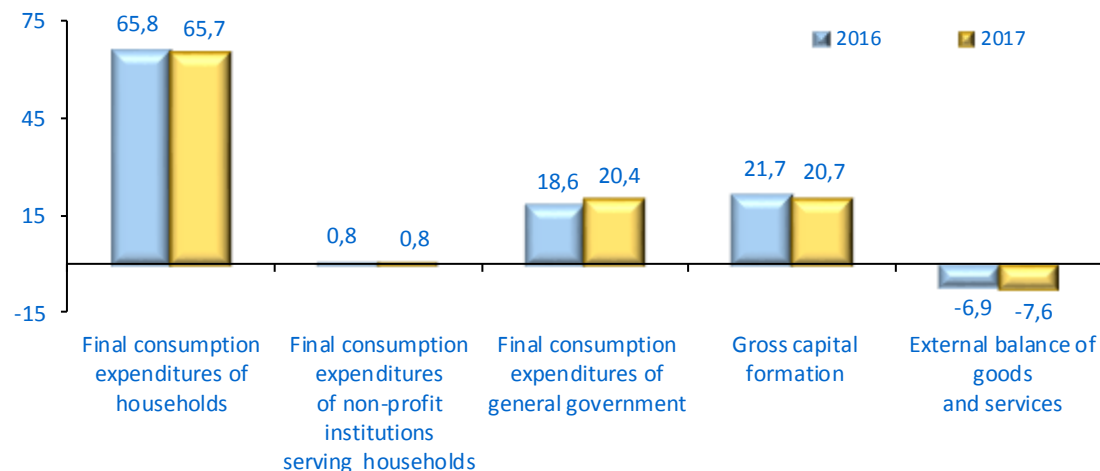

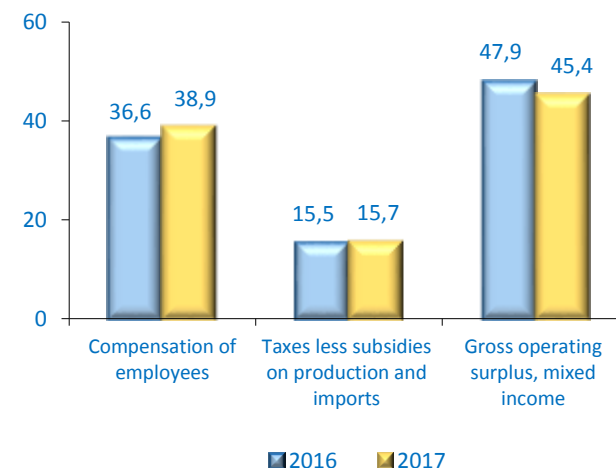

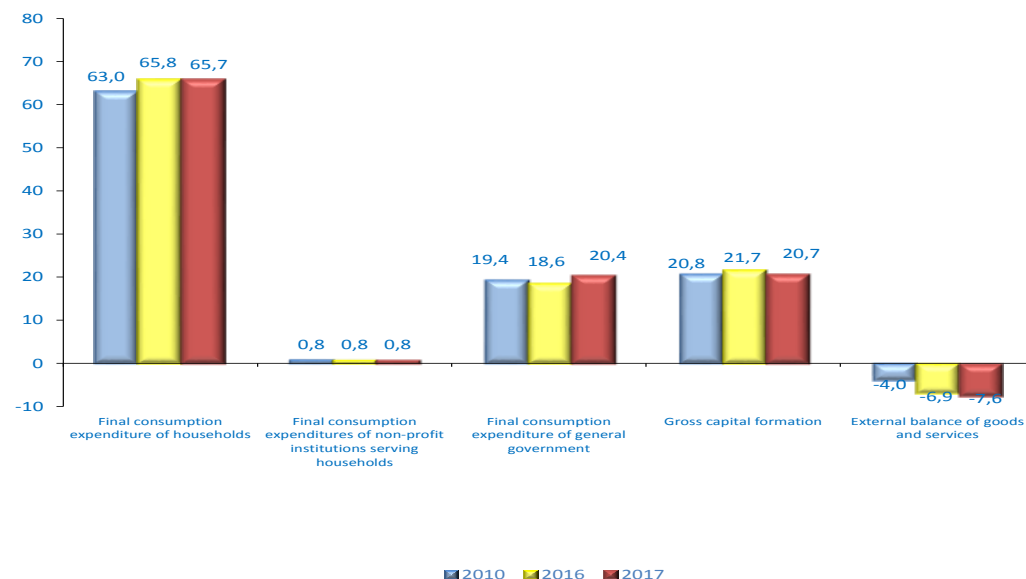

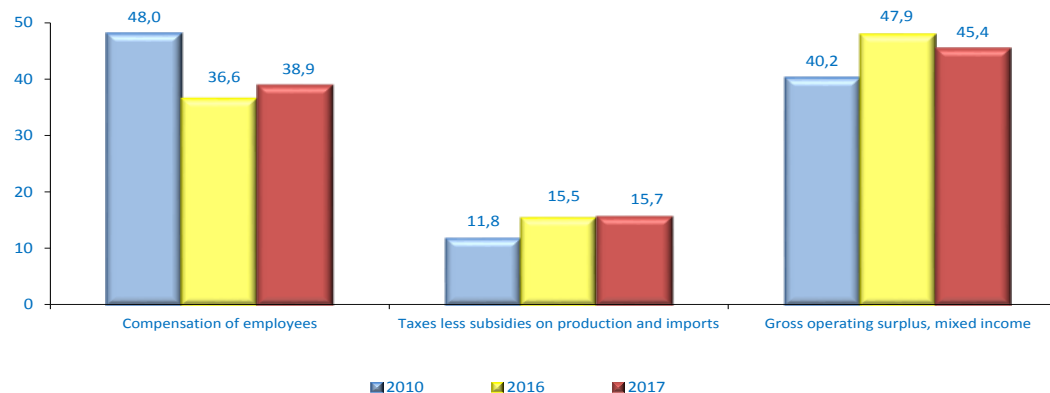

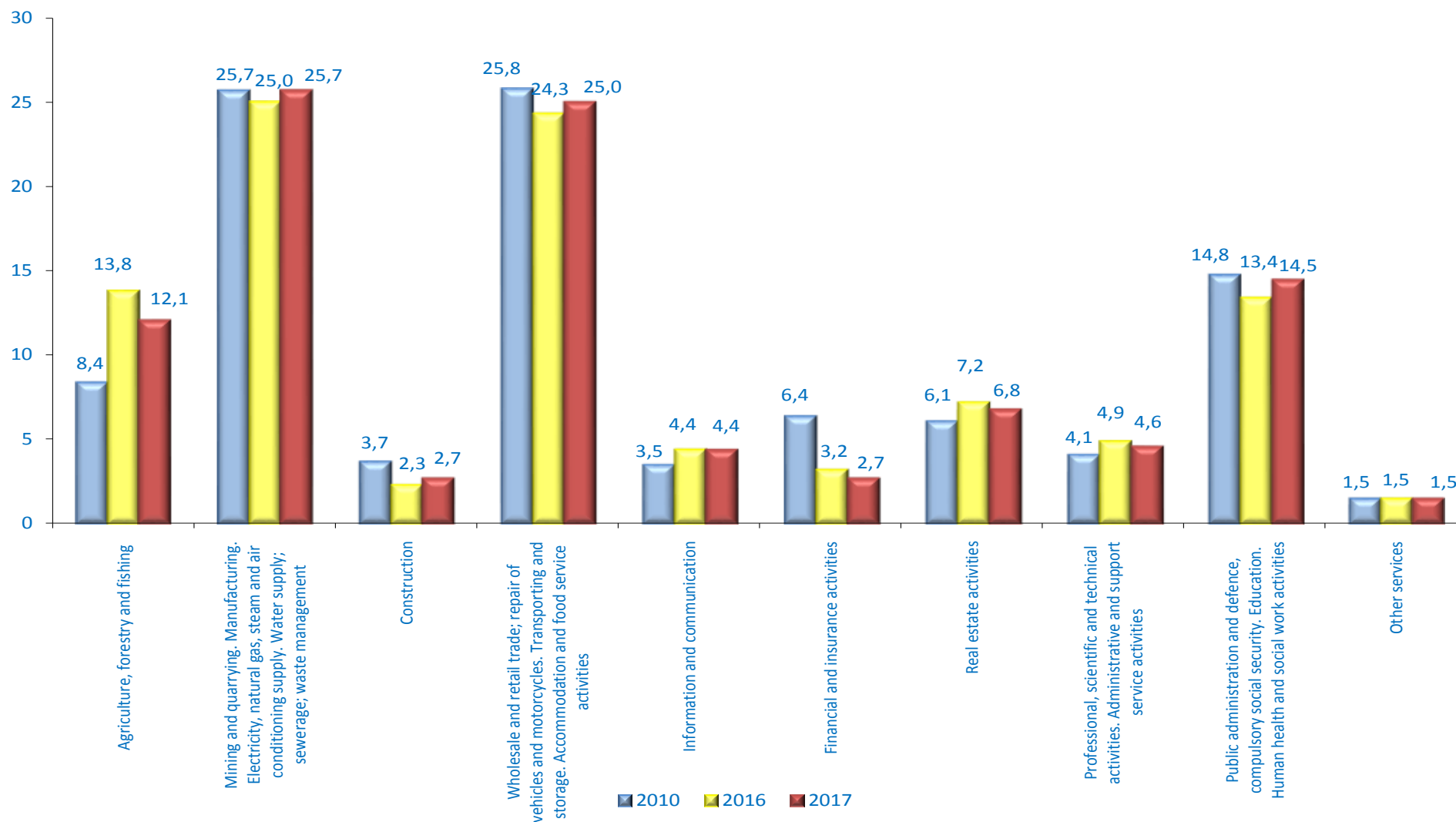

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Gross value added structure by type of economic activity, %





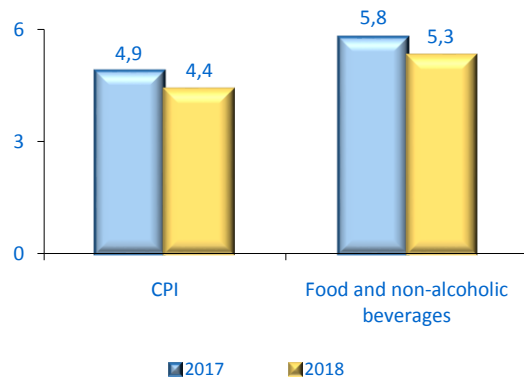

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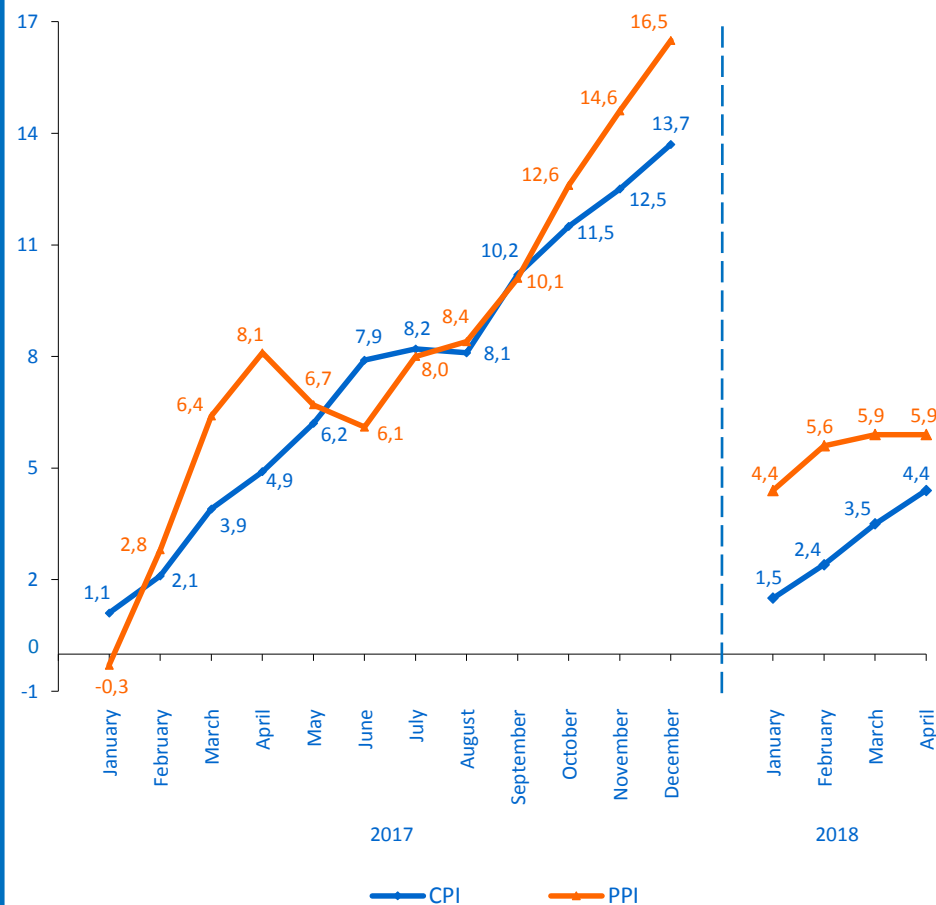

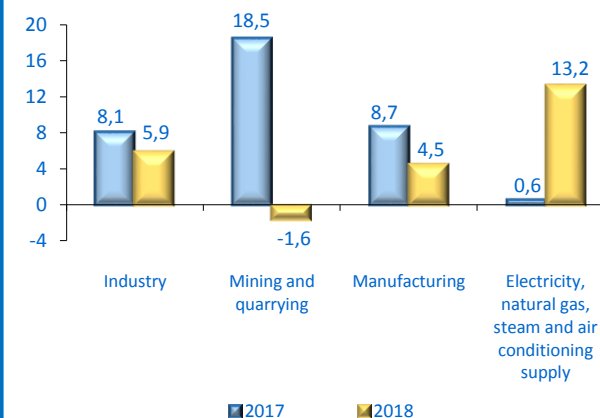
CPI and PPI changes, %

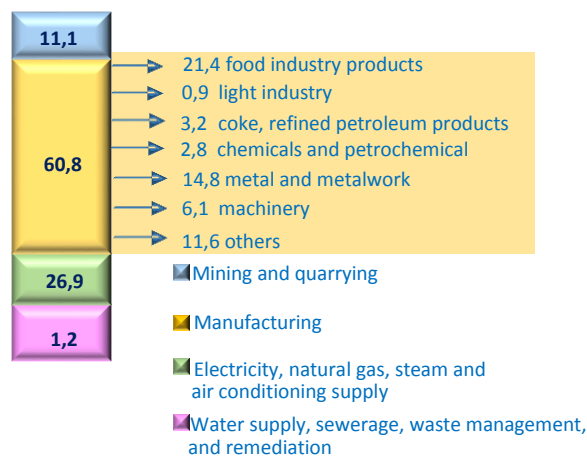




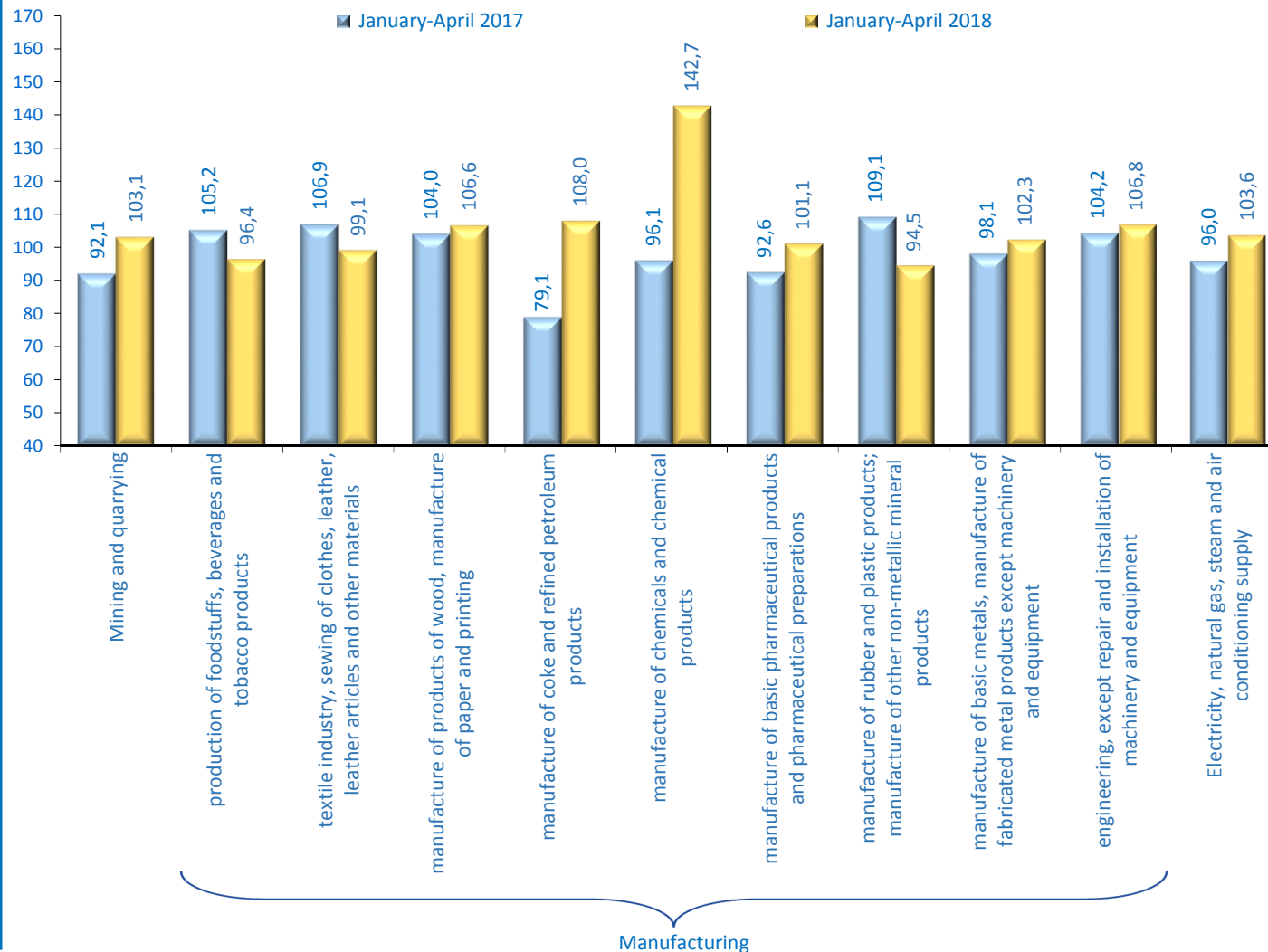

Index of industrial production by type of activity, % (to the corresponding period of the previous year)



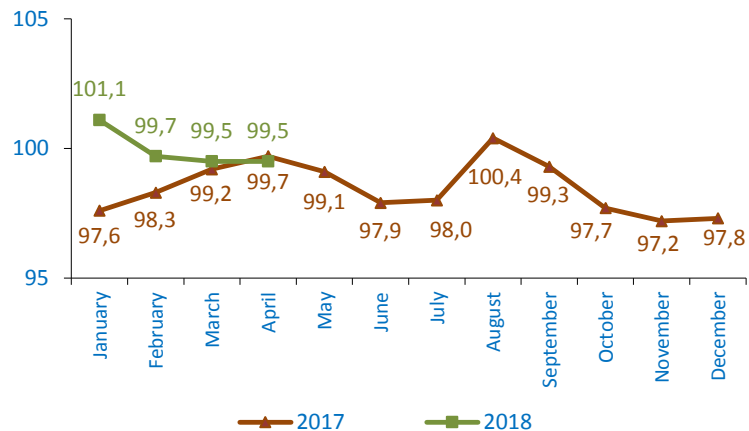

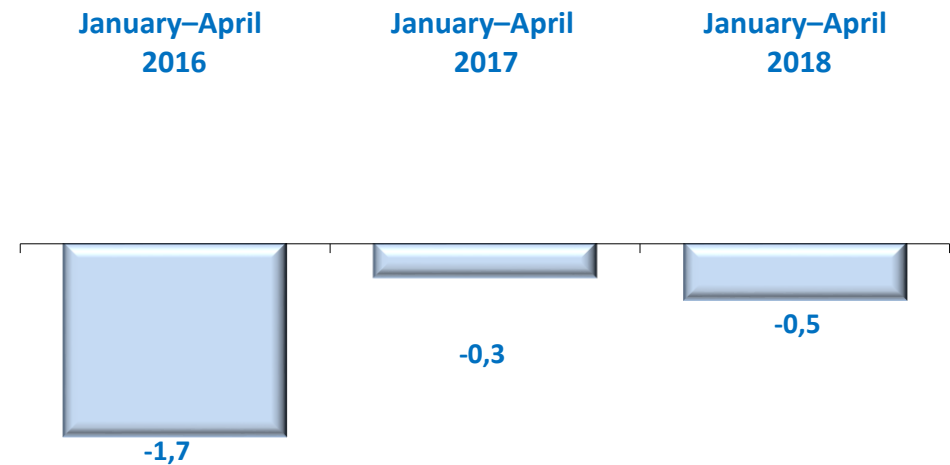
Indices of agricultural production, %

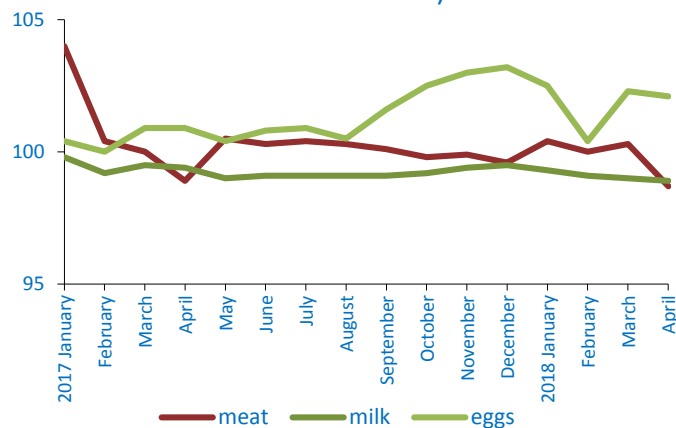

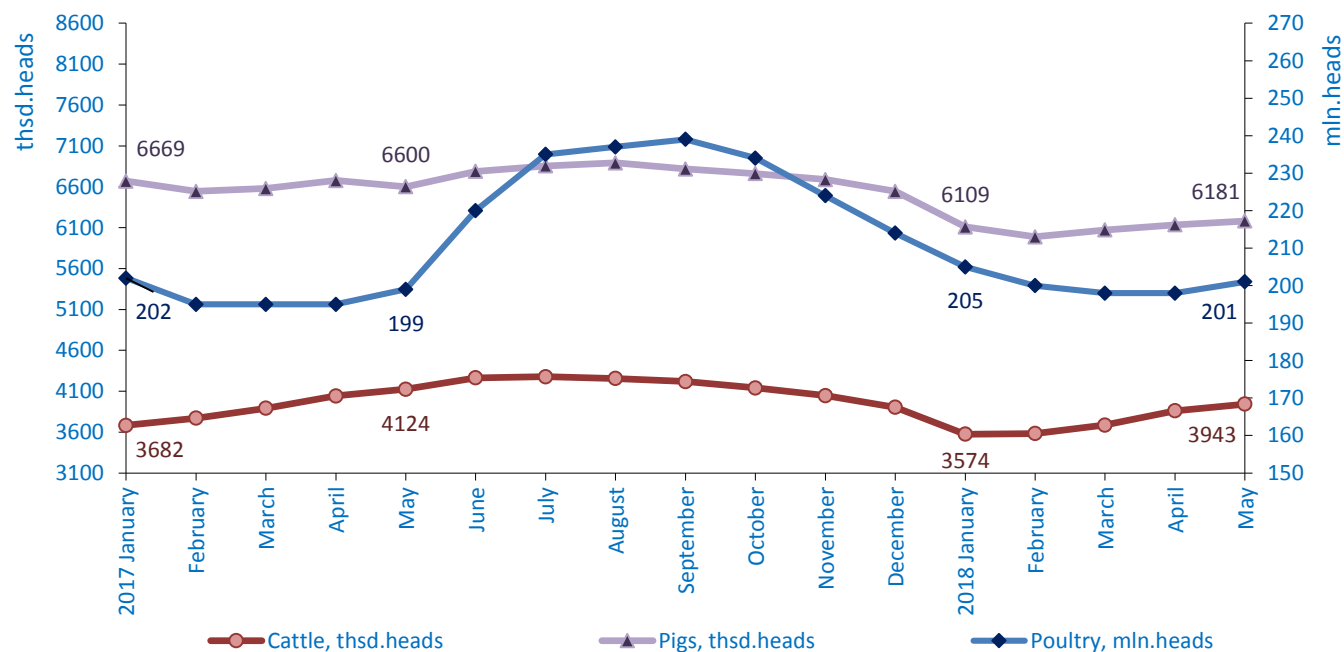

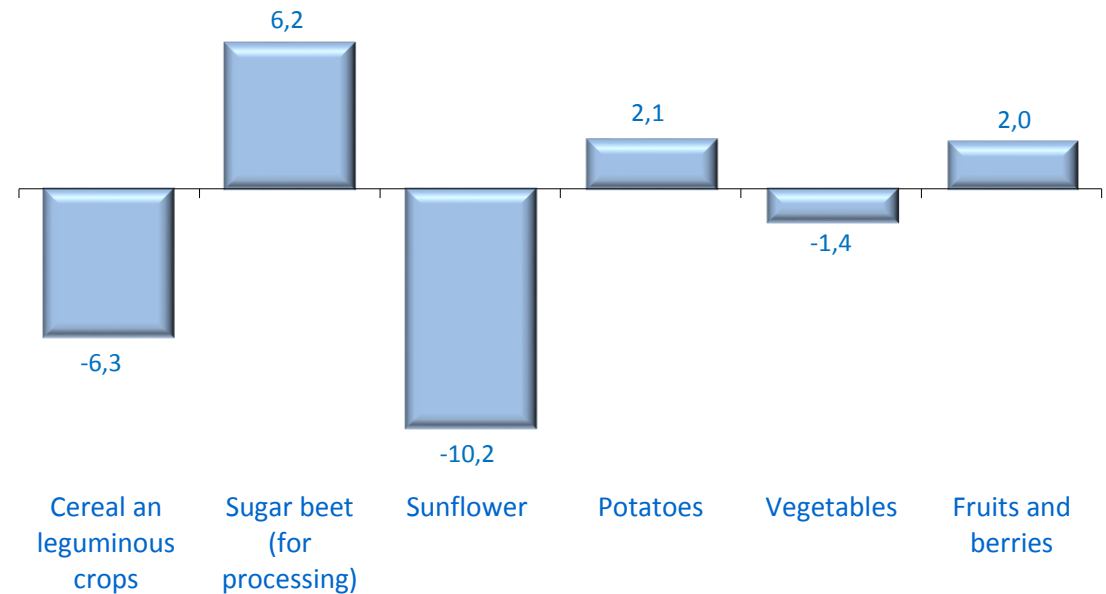

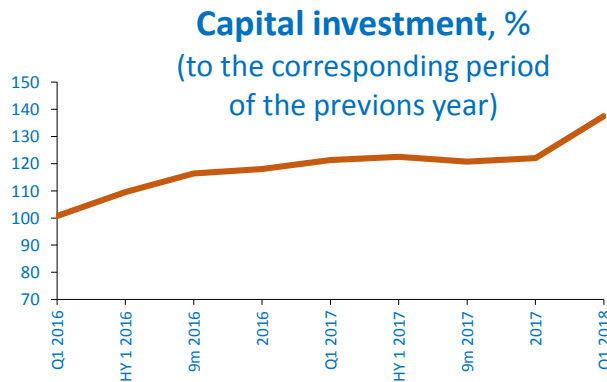

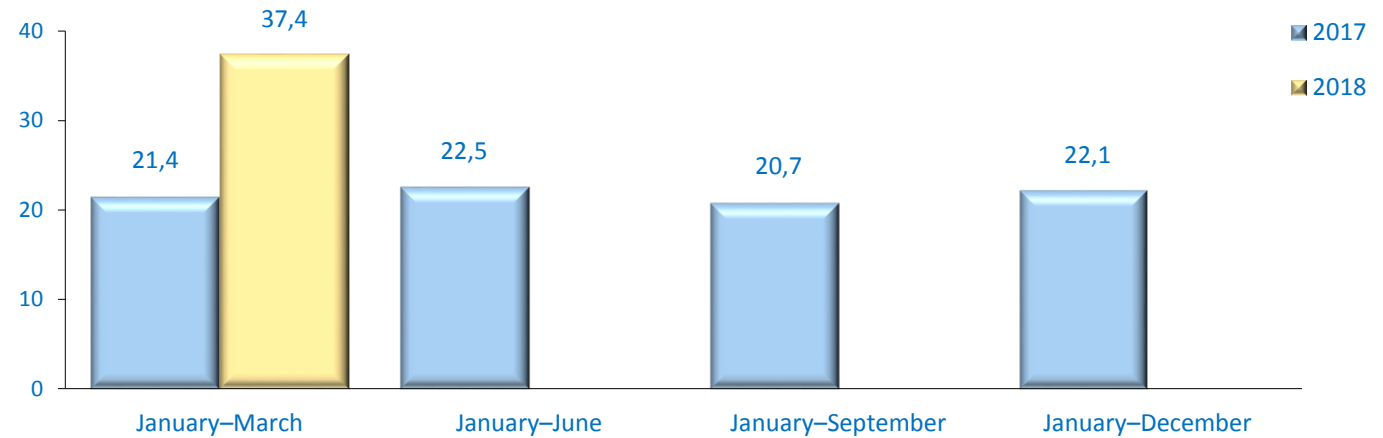

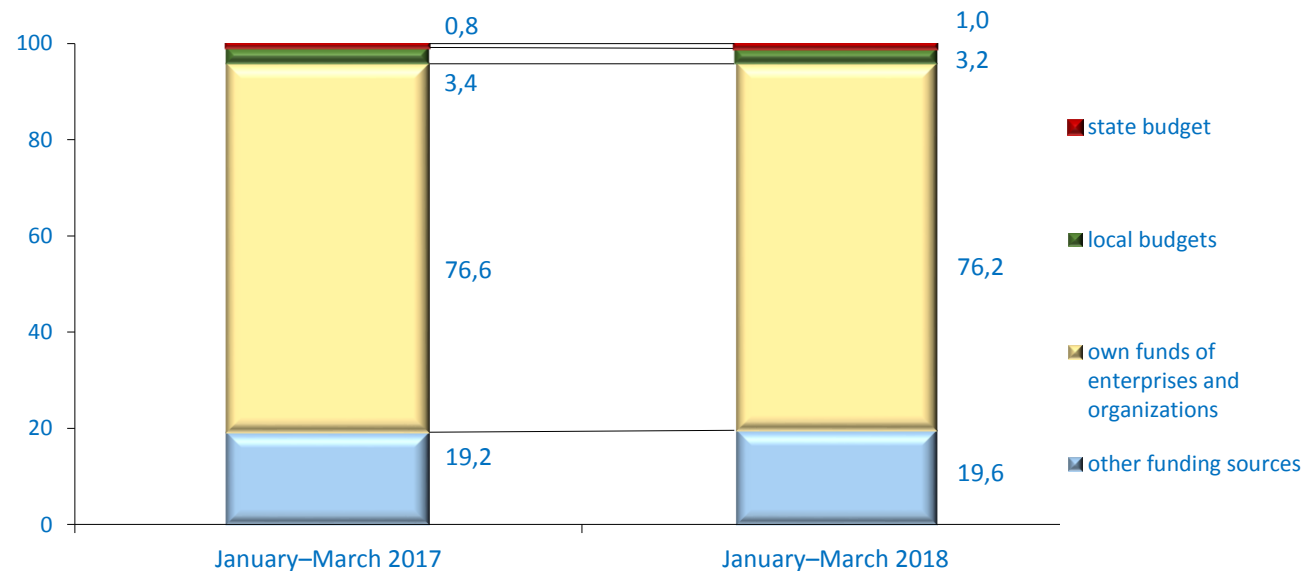

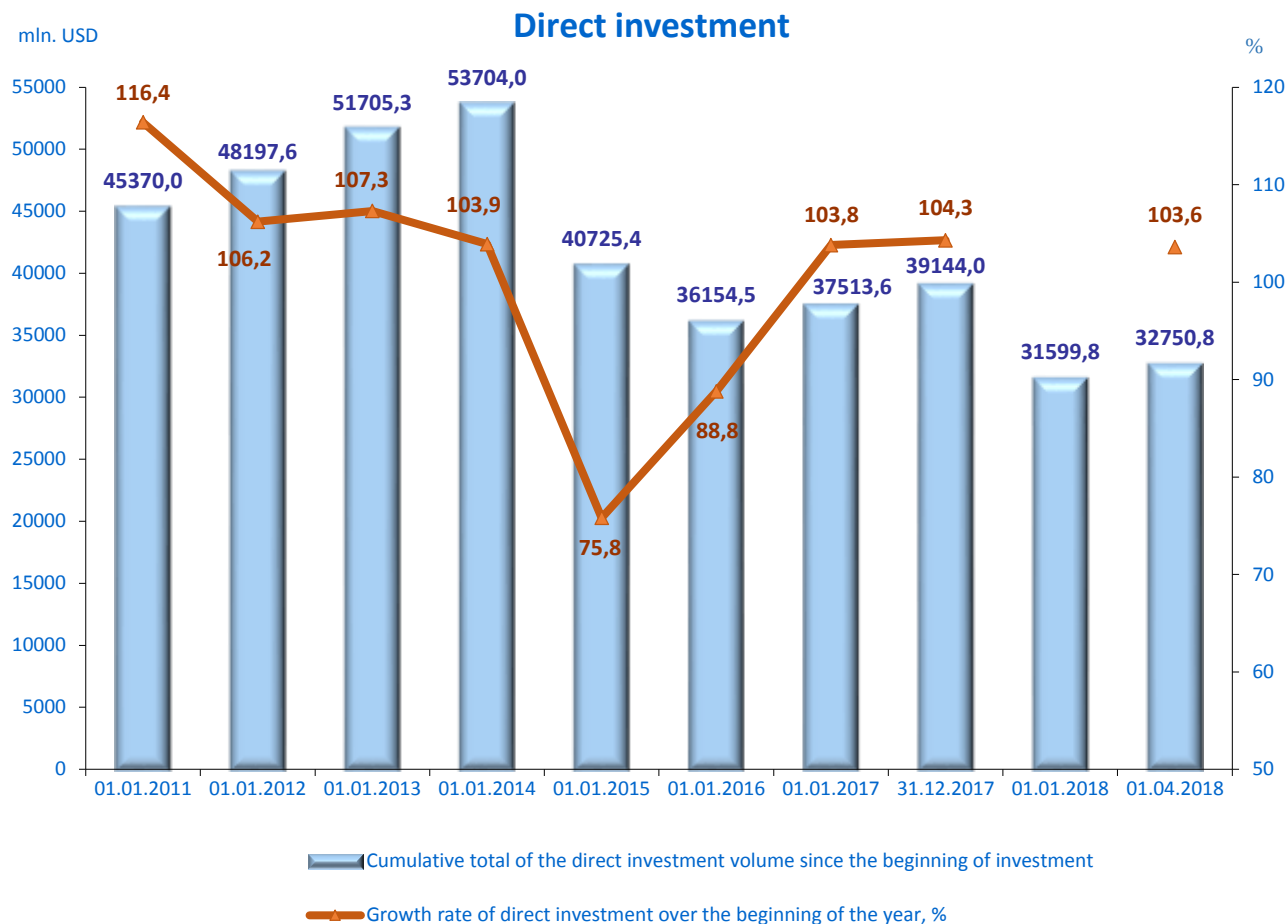

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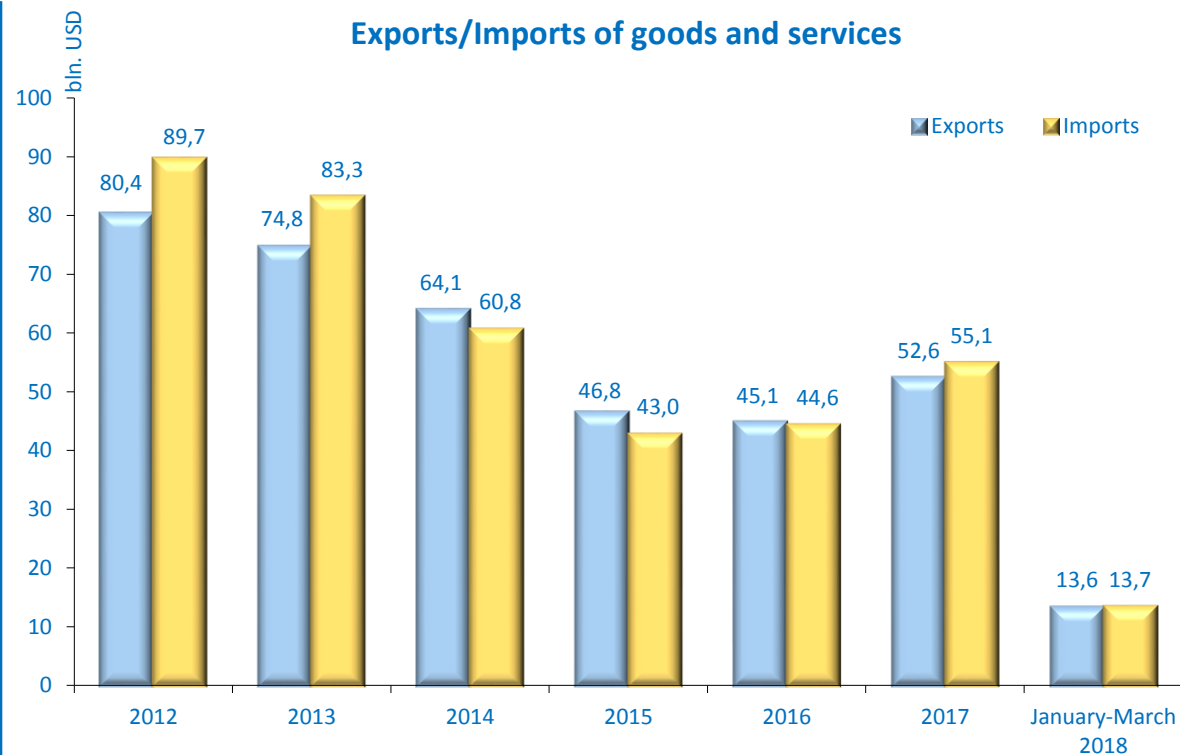

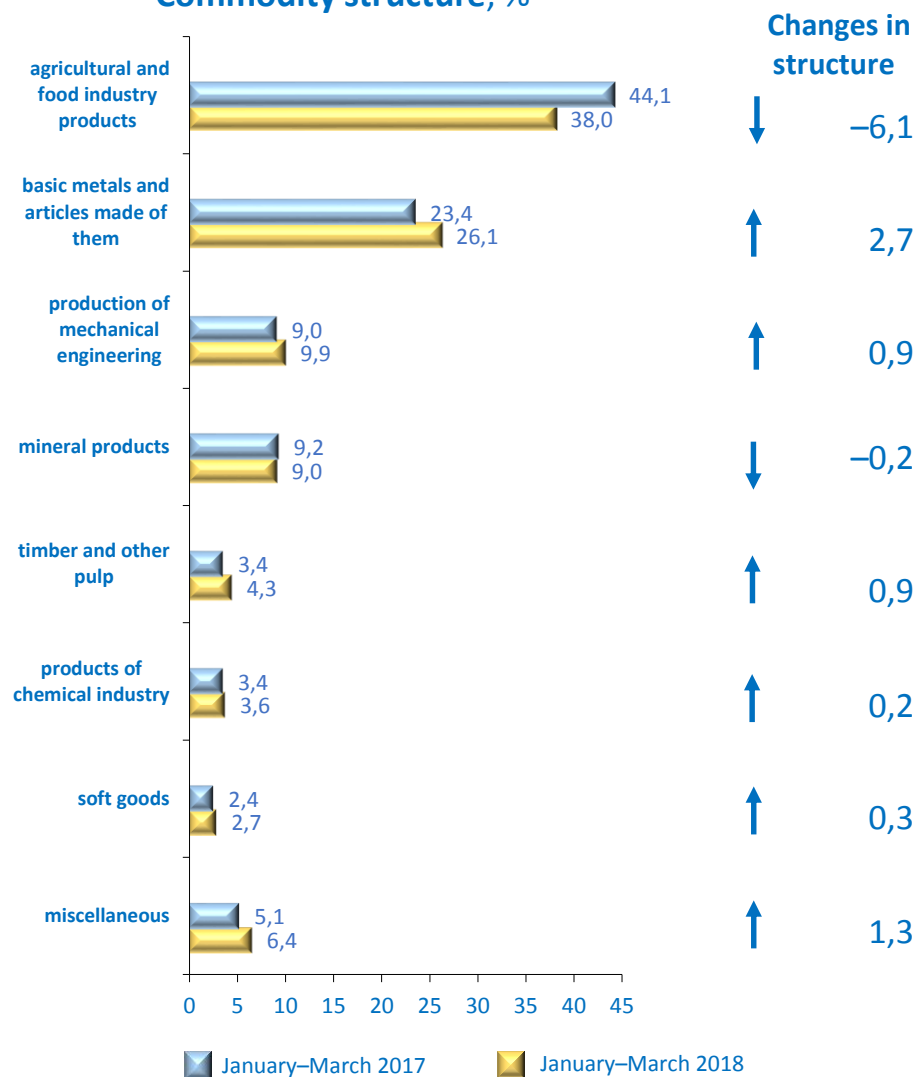

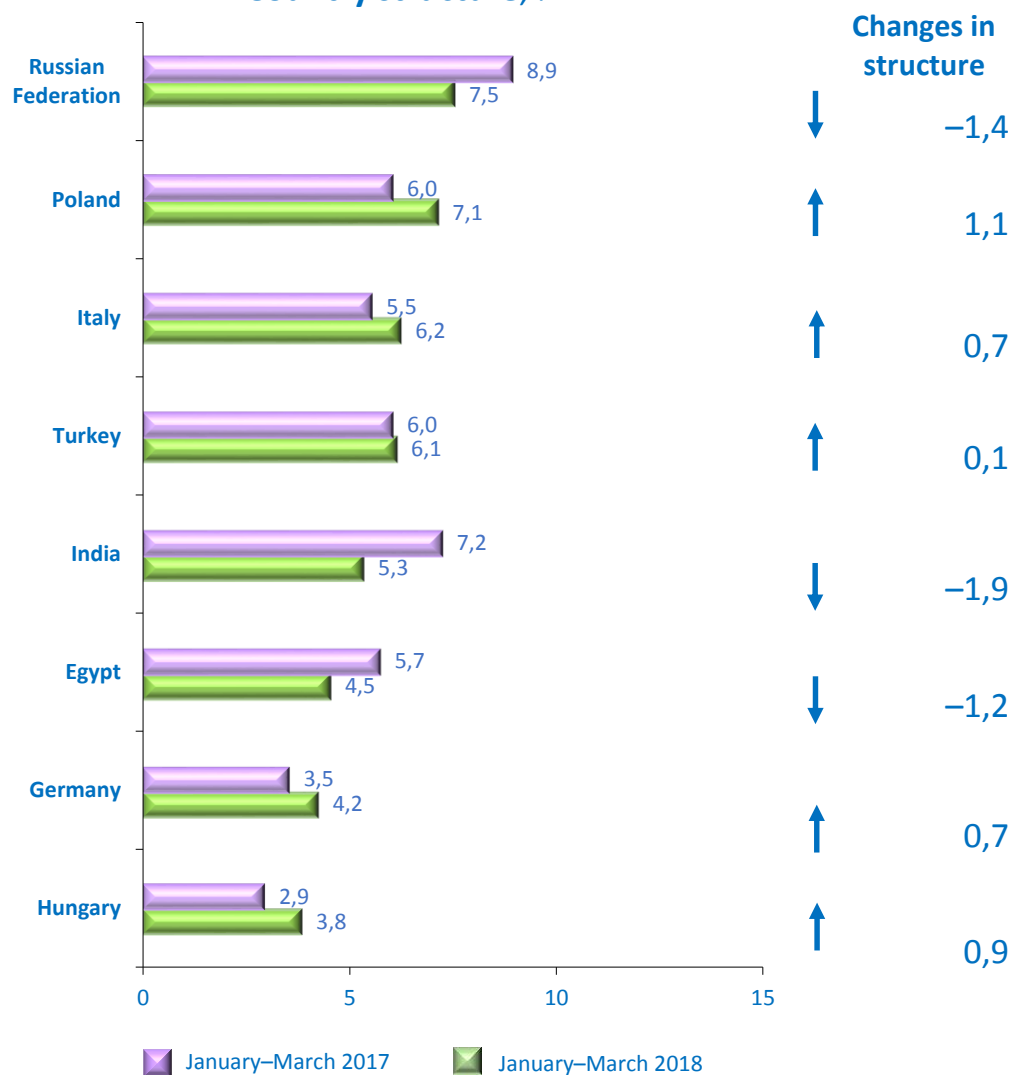


Exports of goods

Country structure, %



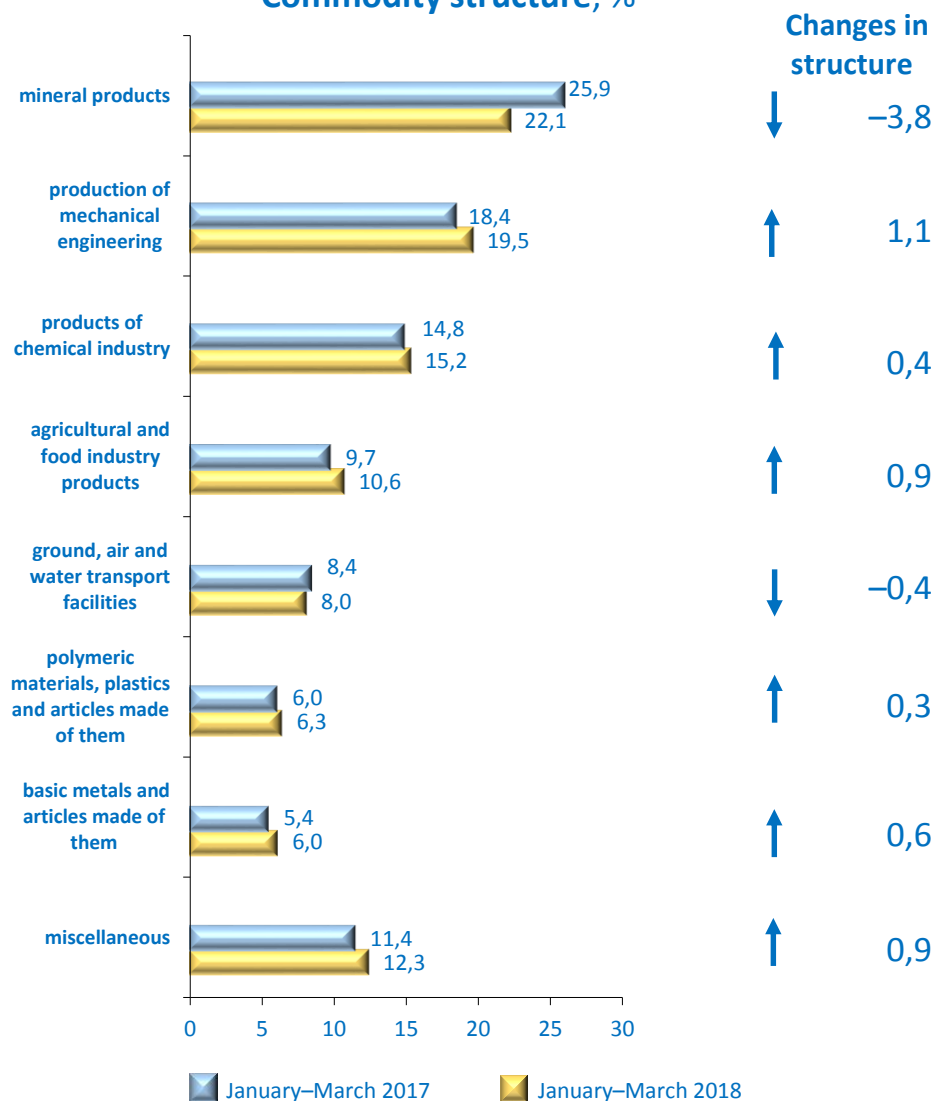

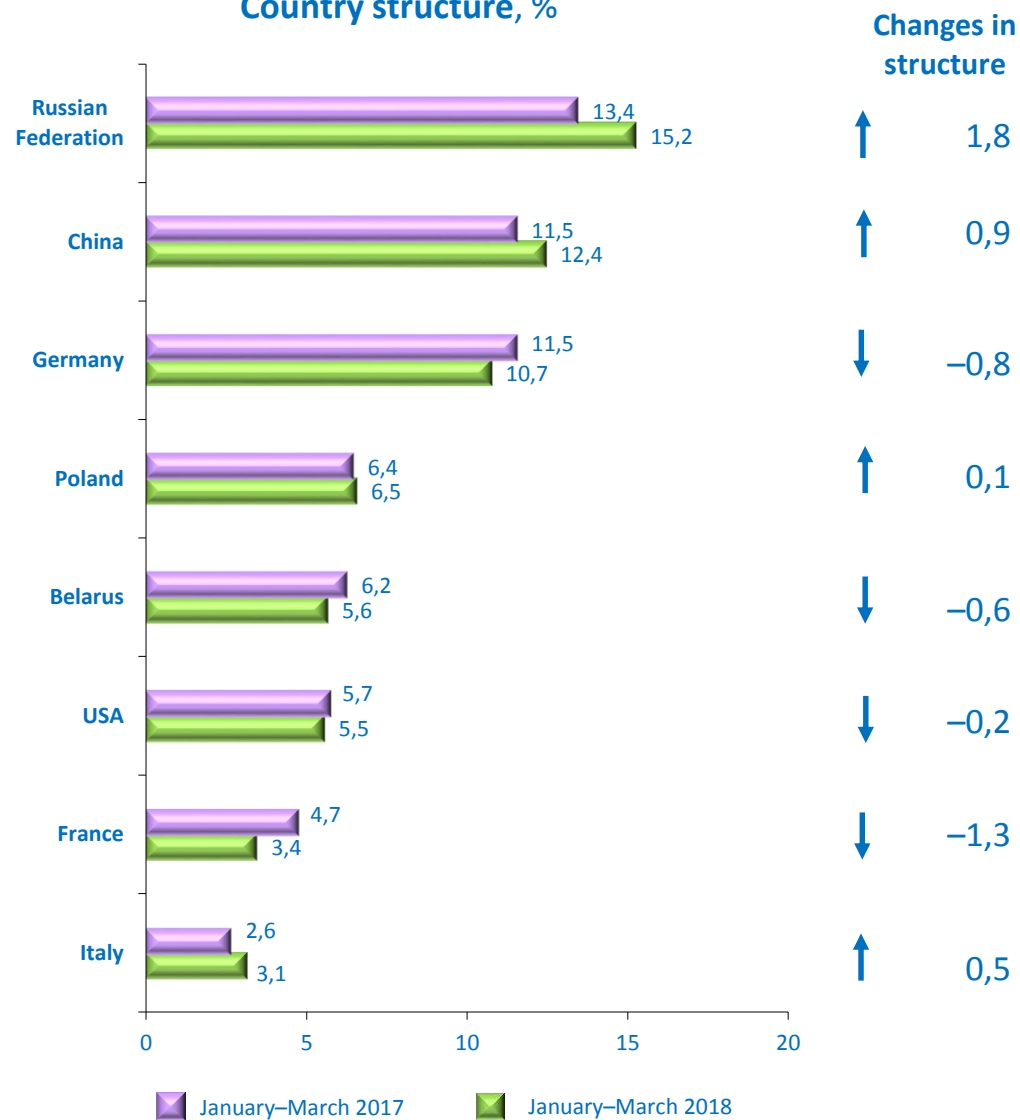

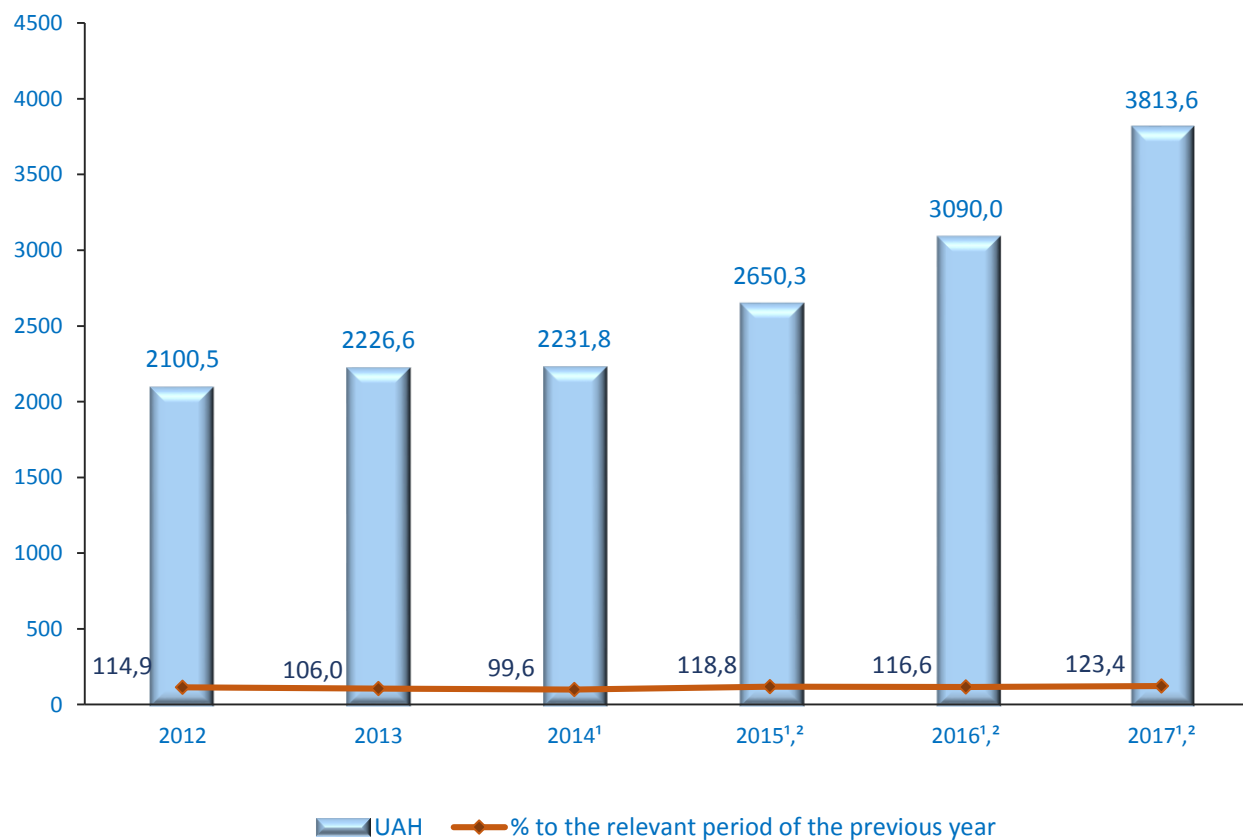

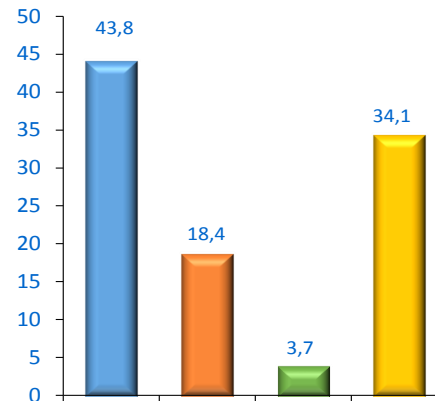

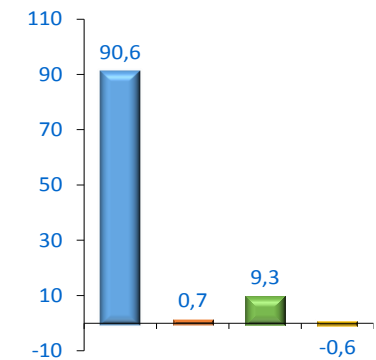

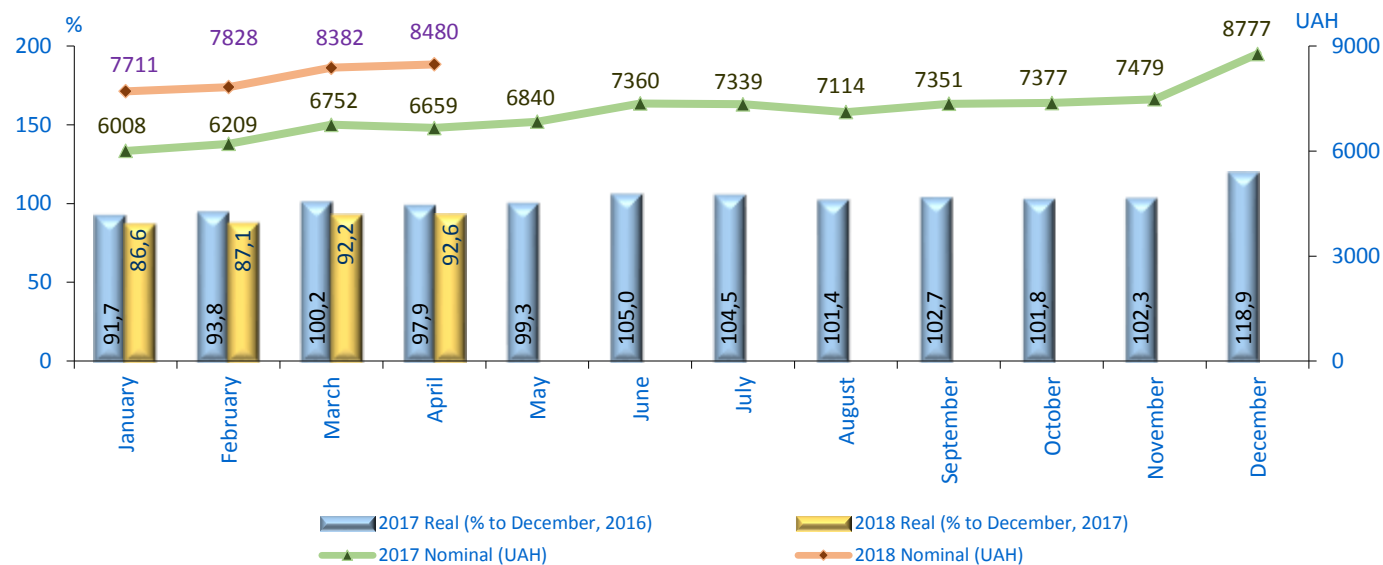

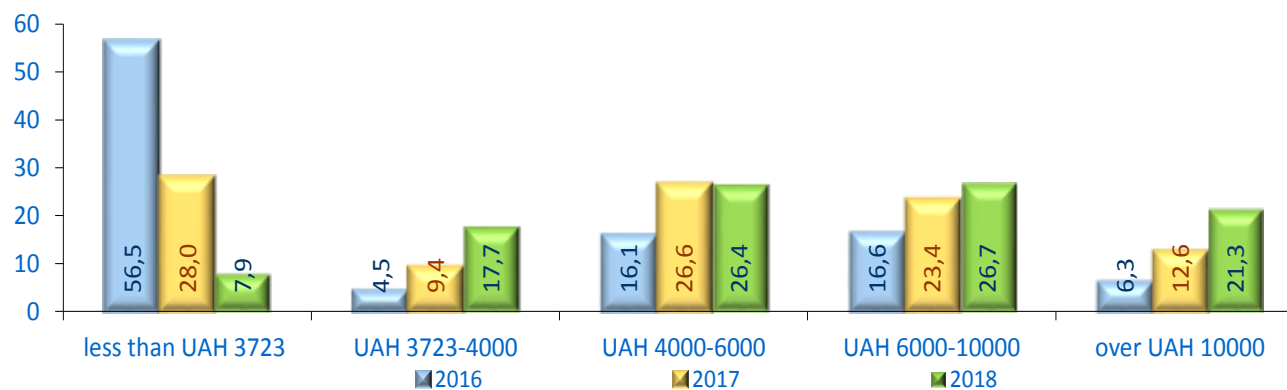

Nominal and real wage trends



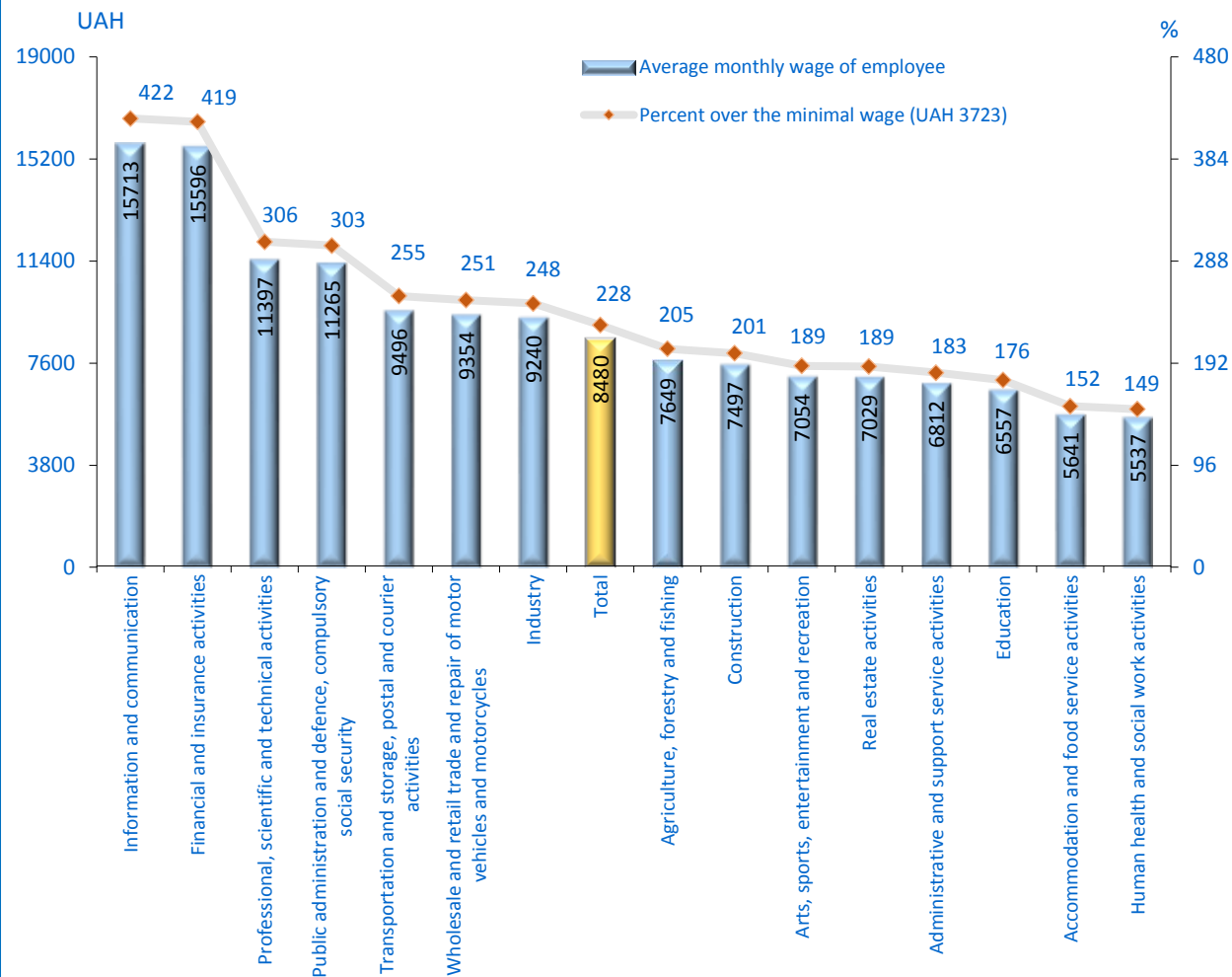
Regular employees by wage level in March, %





Wage of regular employees by type of economic activity, April 2018

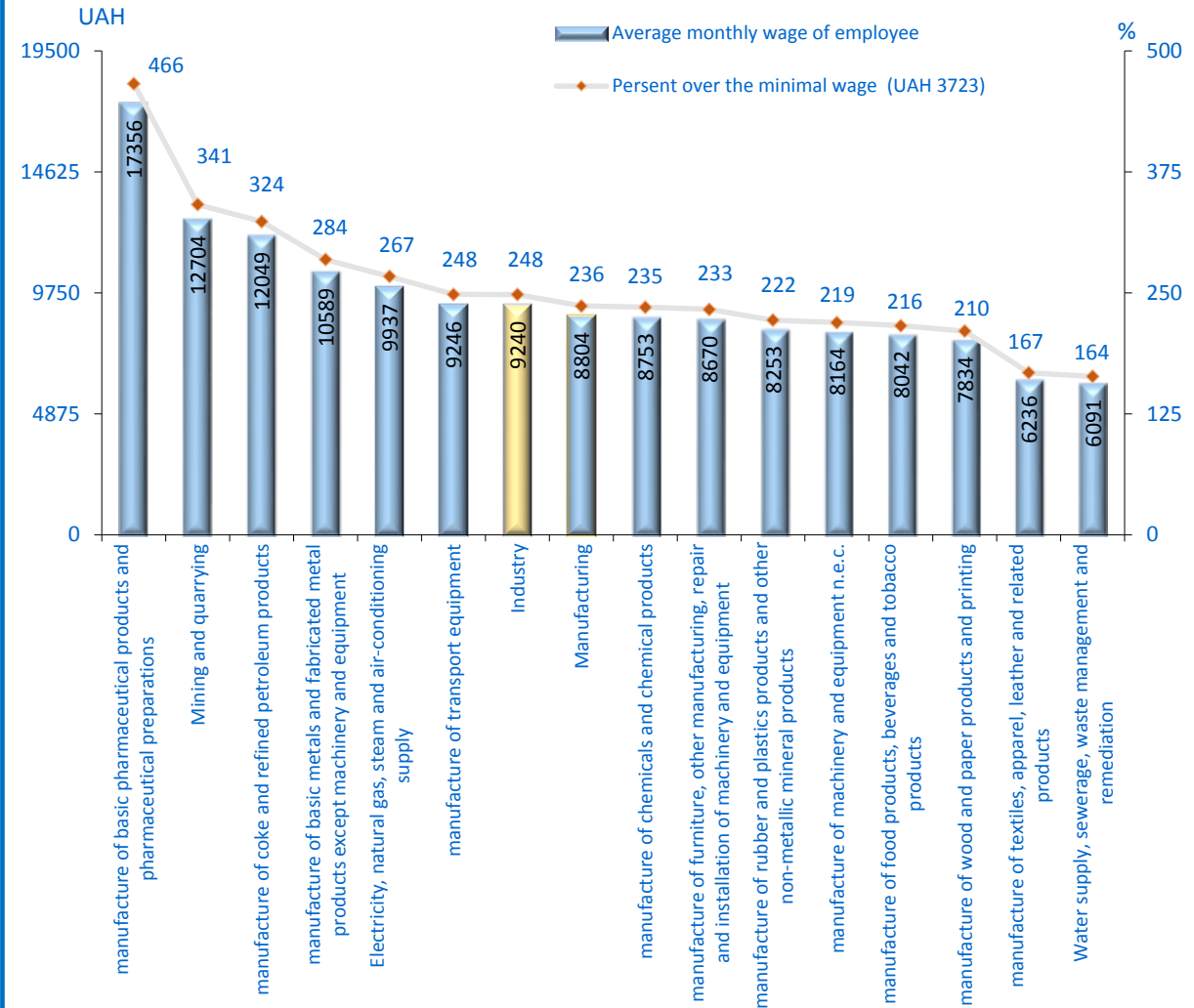

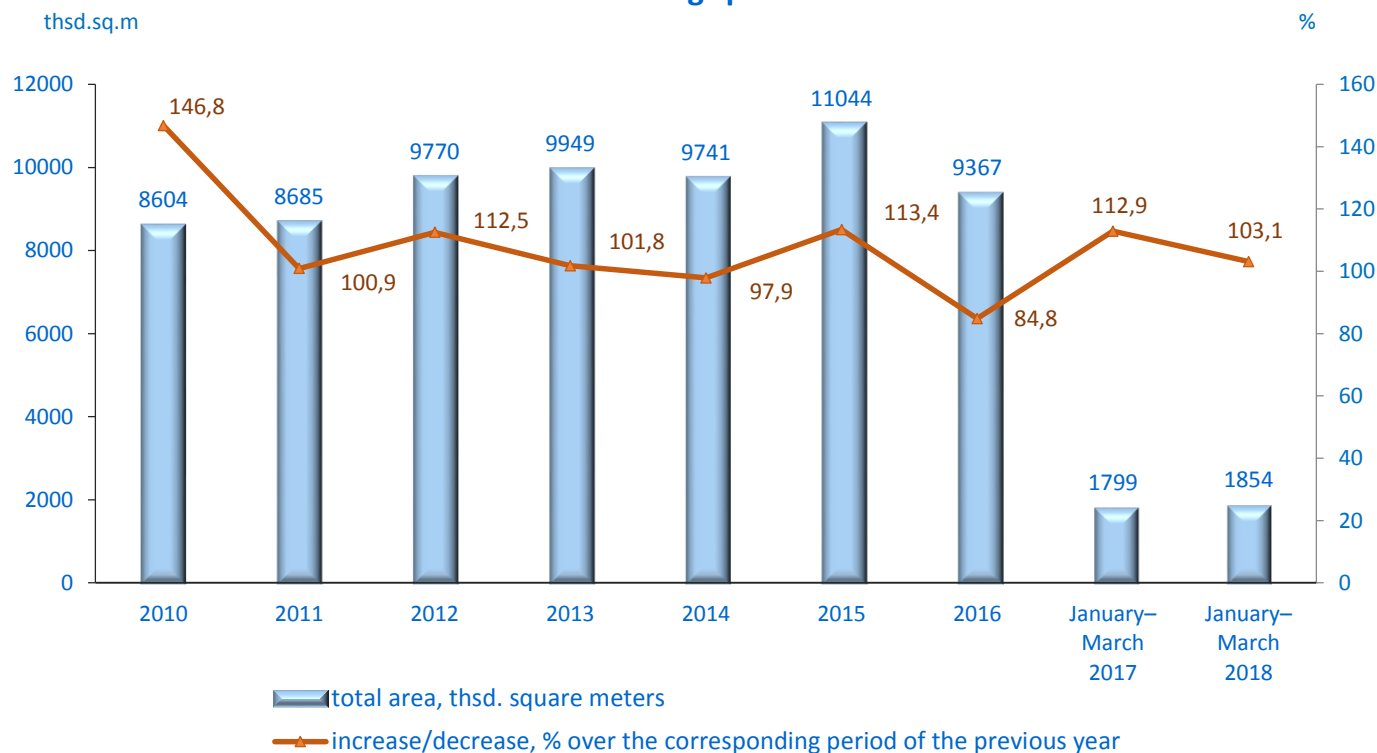

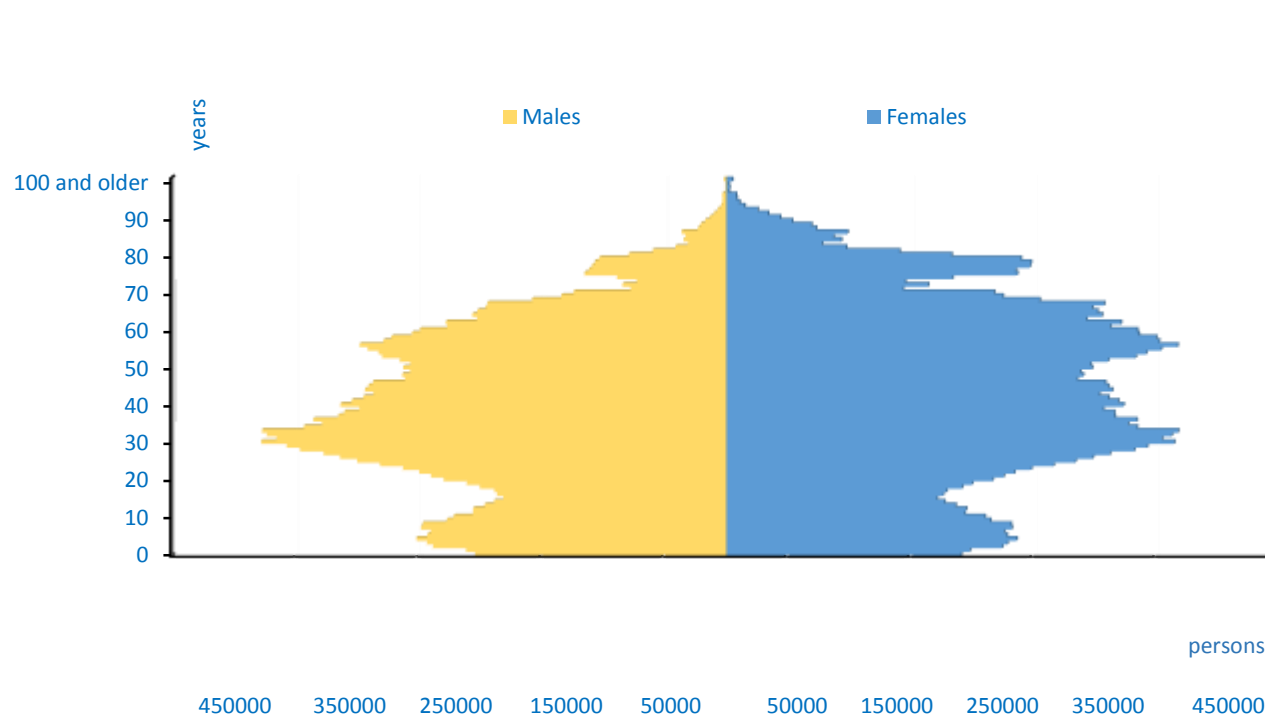
