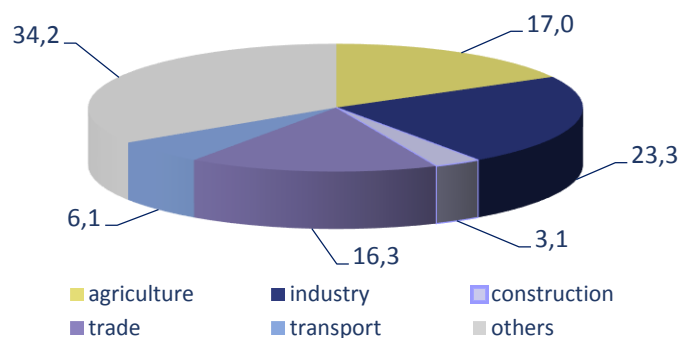

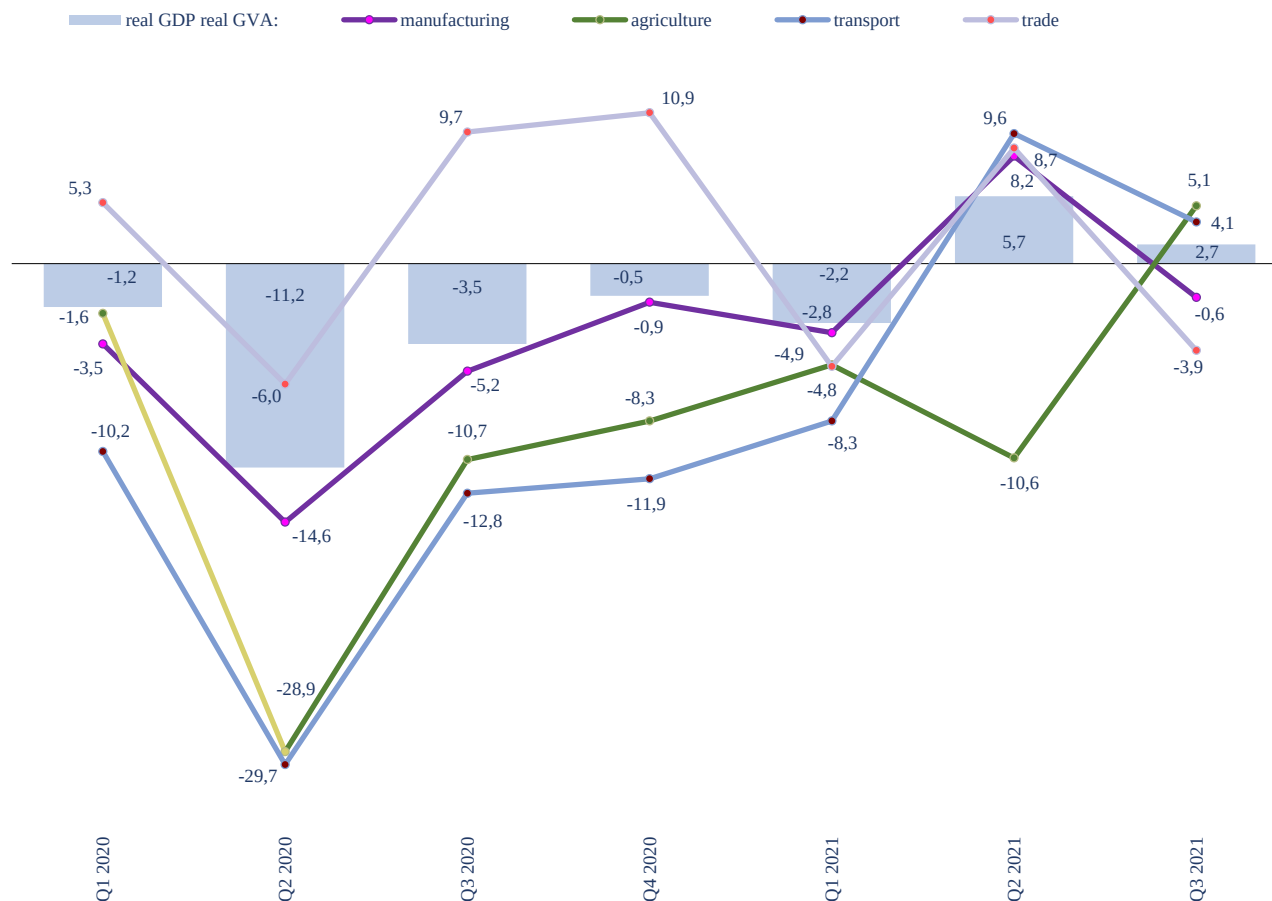
Gross value added structure for III quarter 2021, %

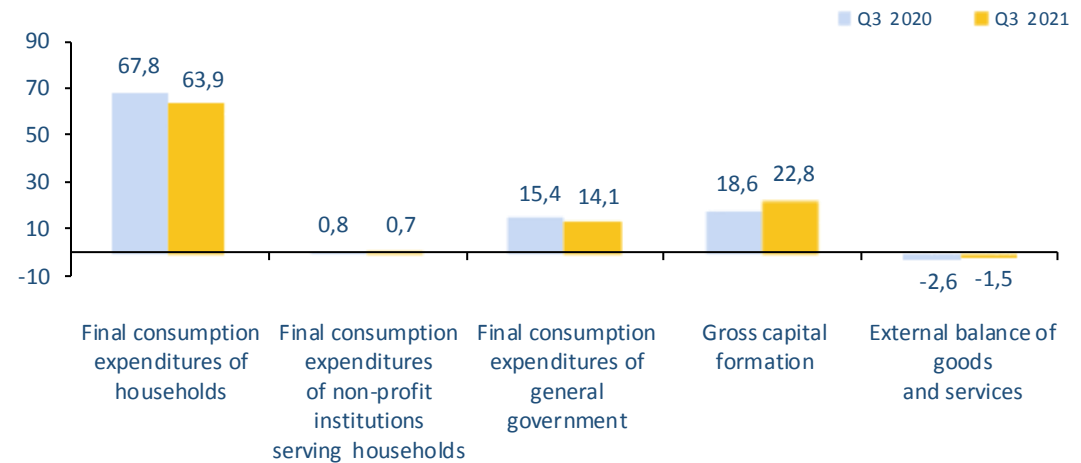

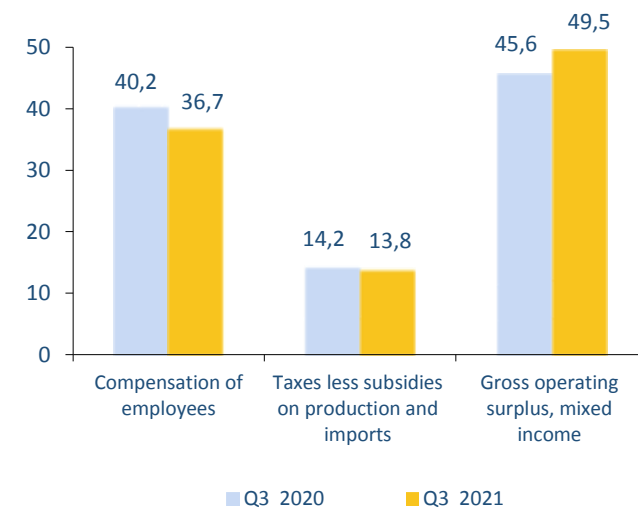
GDP by final use categories, %

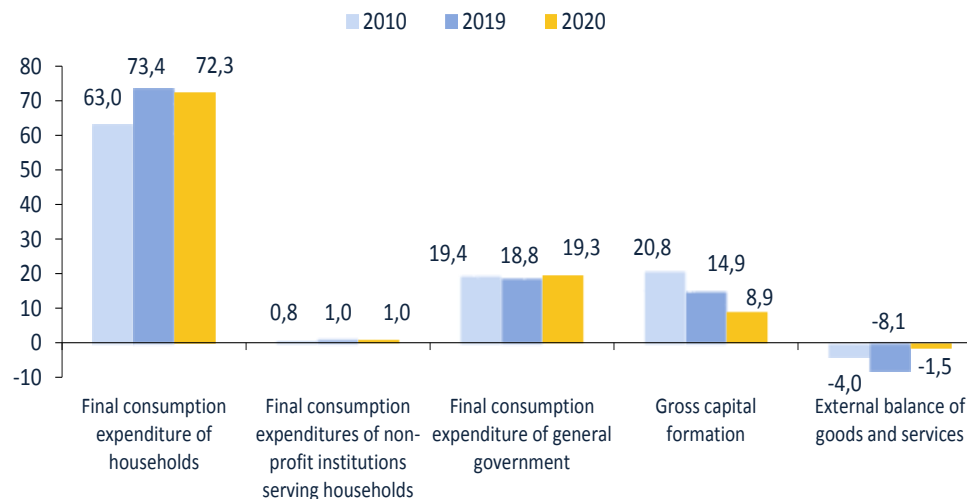

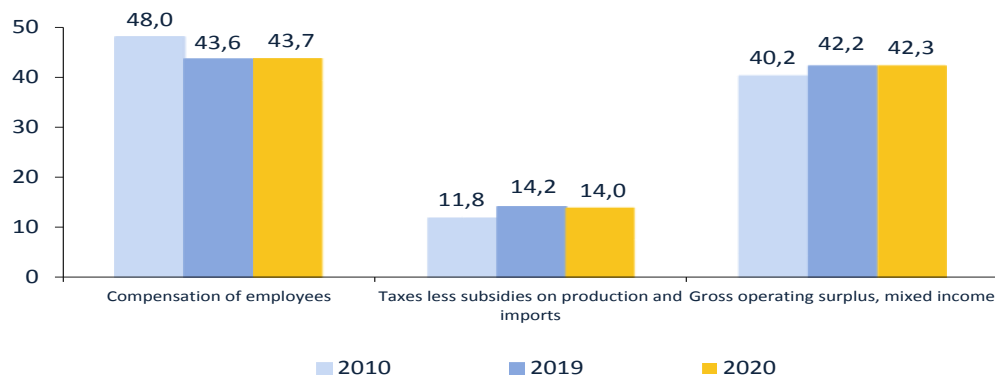

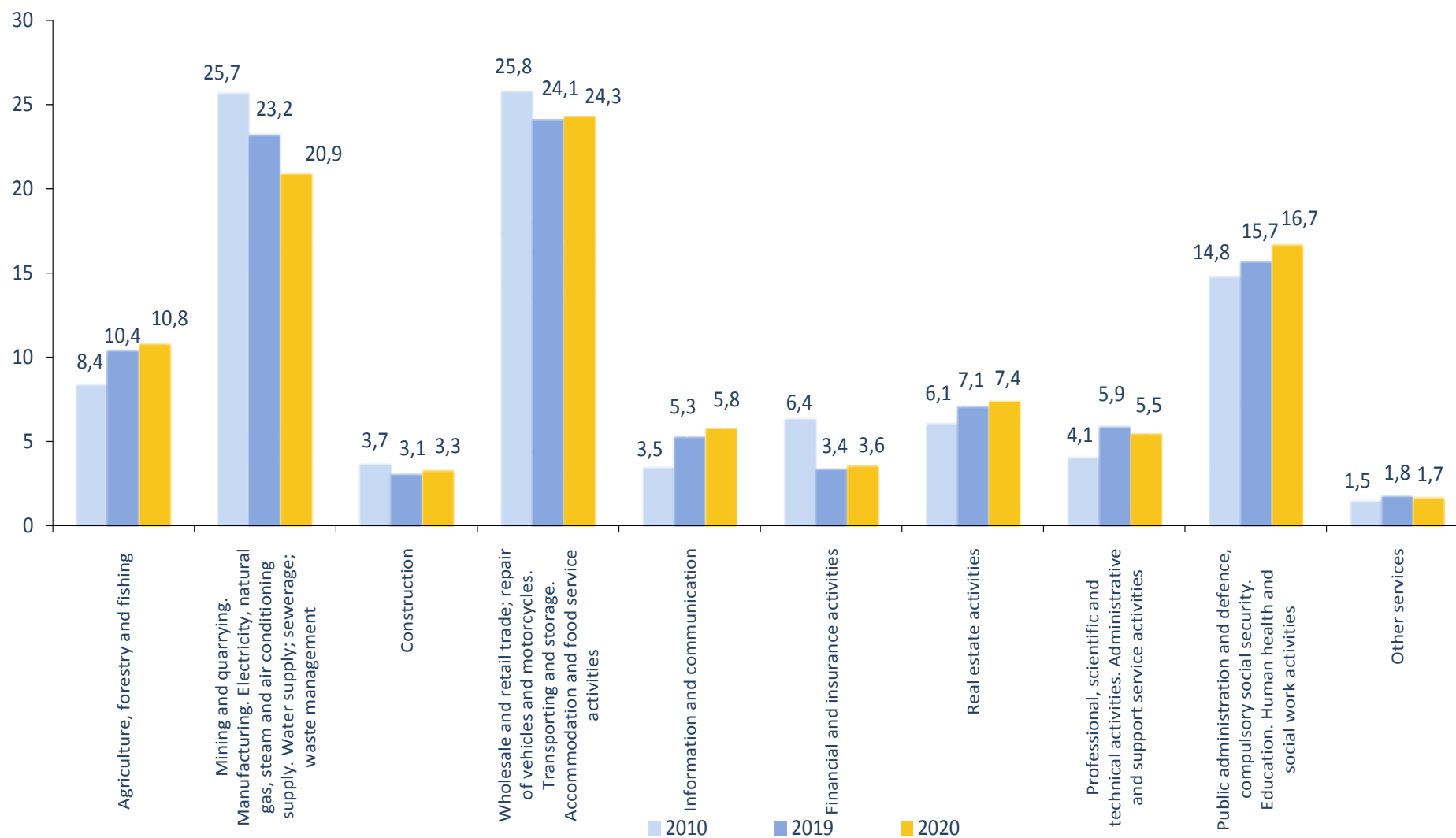
GDP by final use categories, %

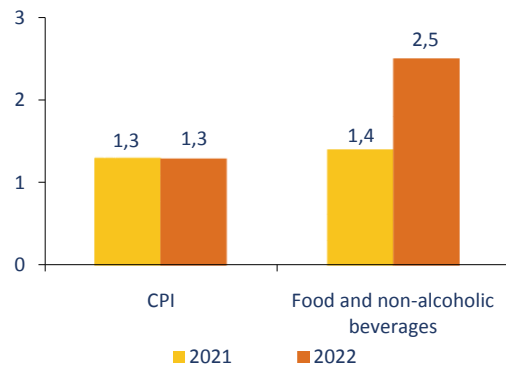
Gross value added structure by type of economic activity, %



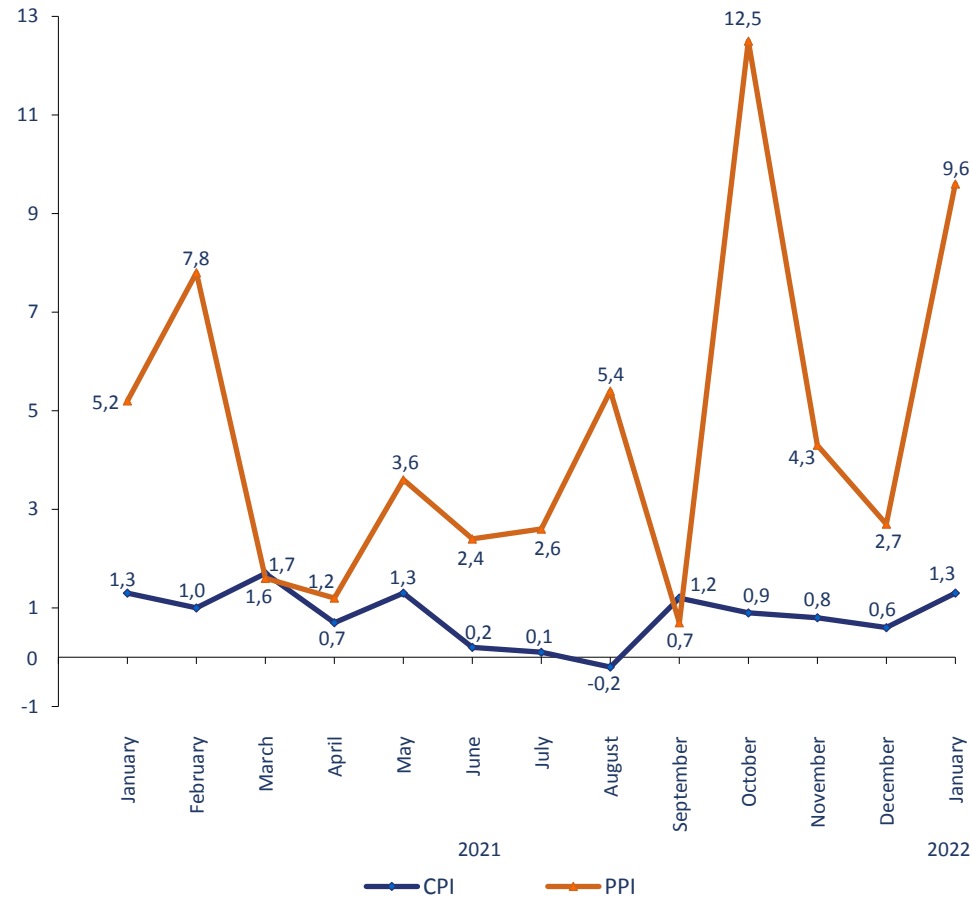

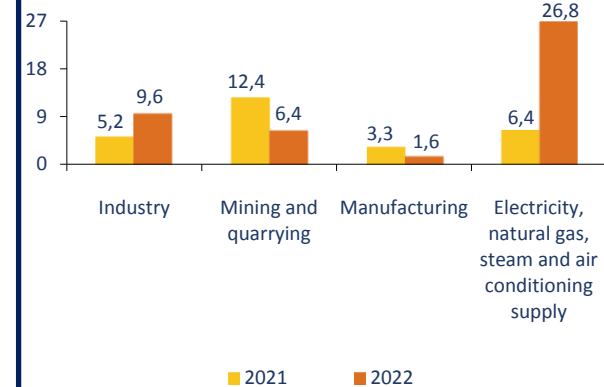
CPI and PPI changes, %

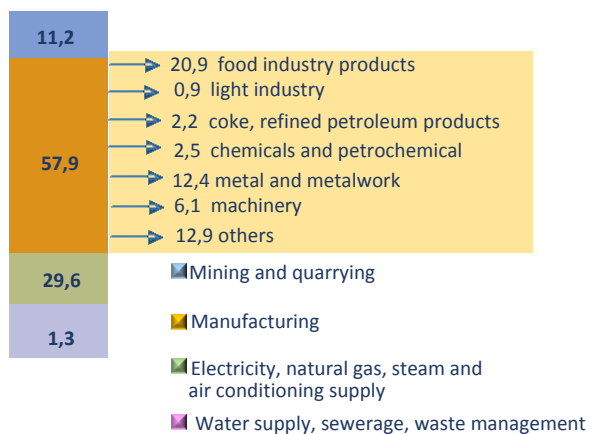

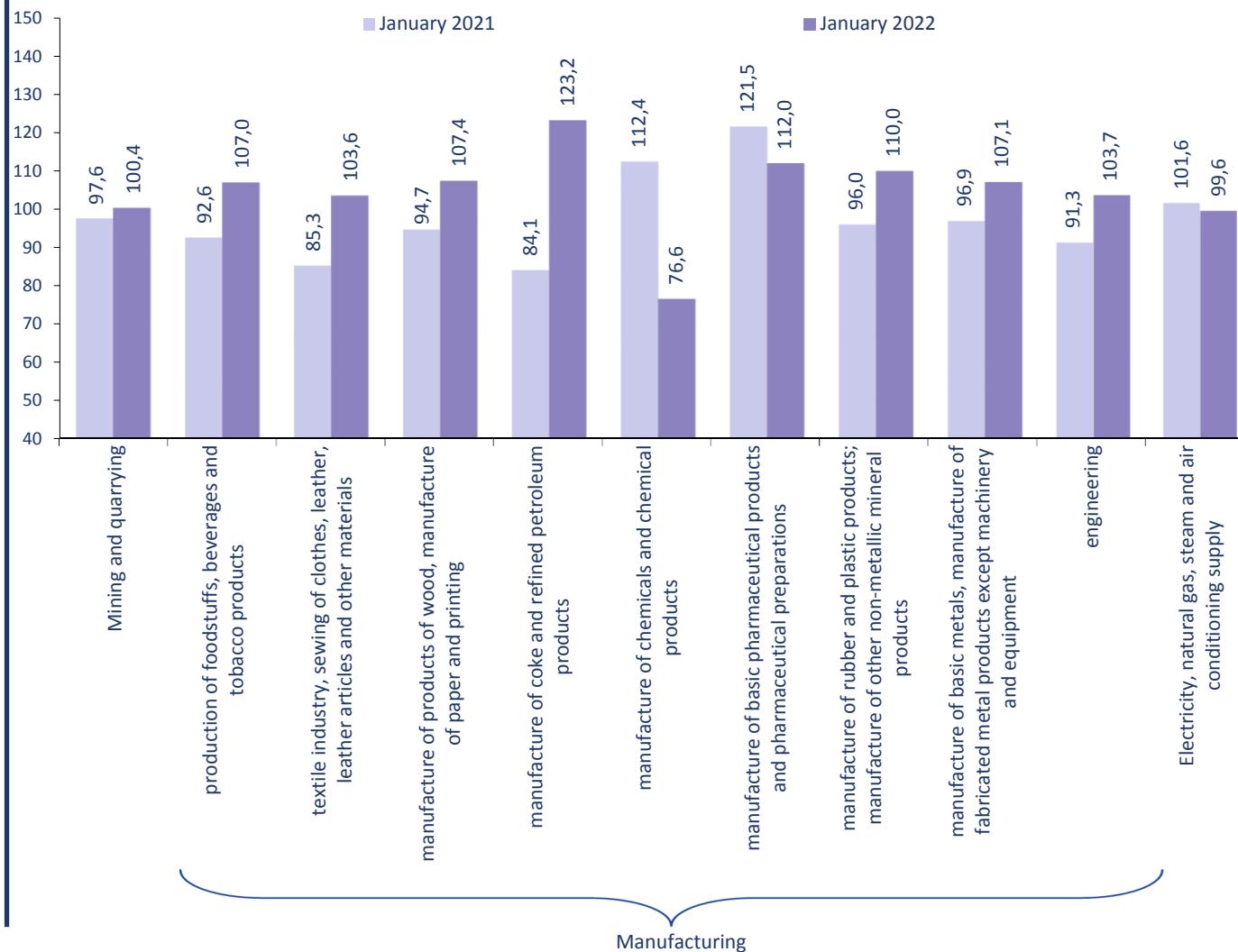

Structure of industrial products sold in 2020, %



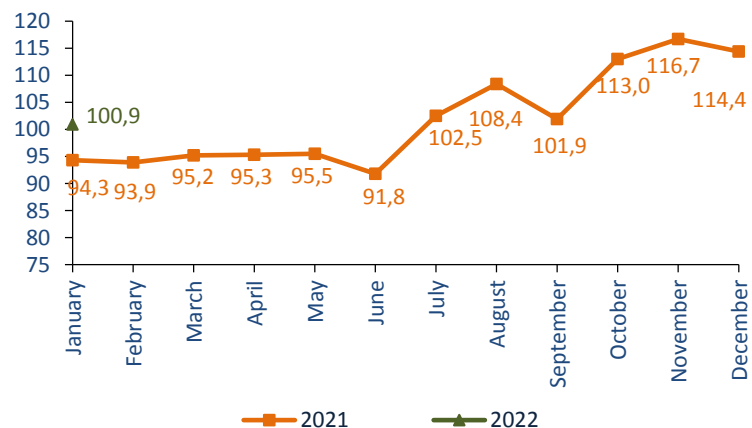
Index of industrial production by type of activity, % (to the corresponding period of the previous year)

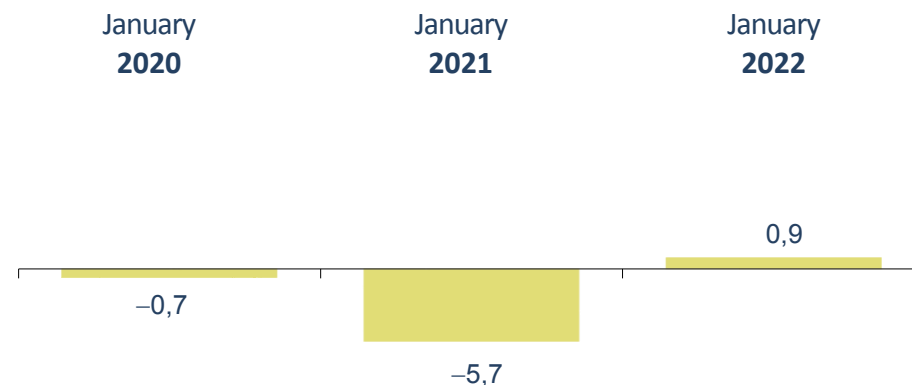

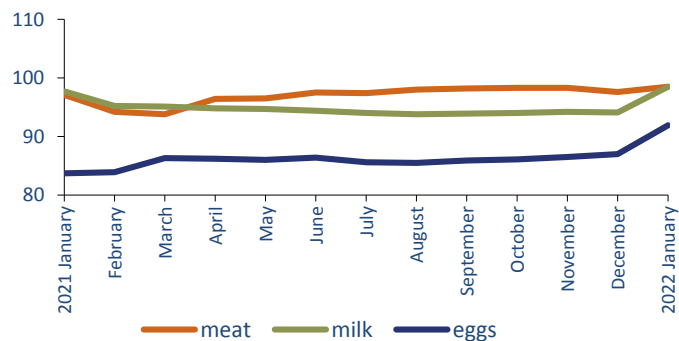

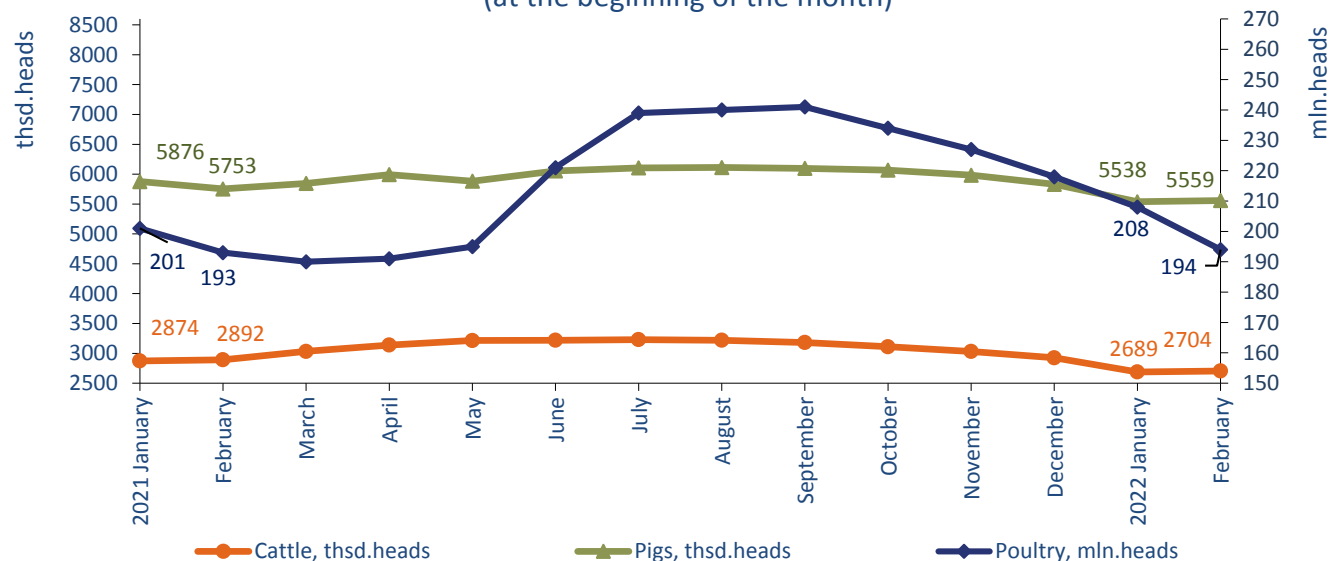
Growth rate of animal products production, %

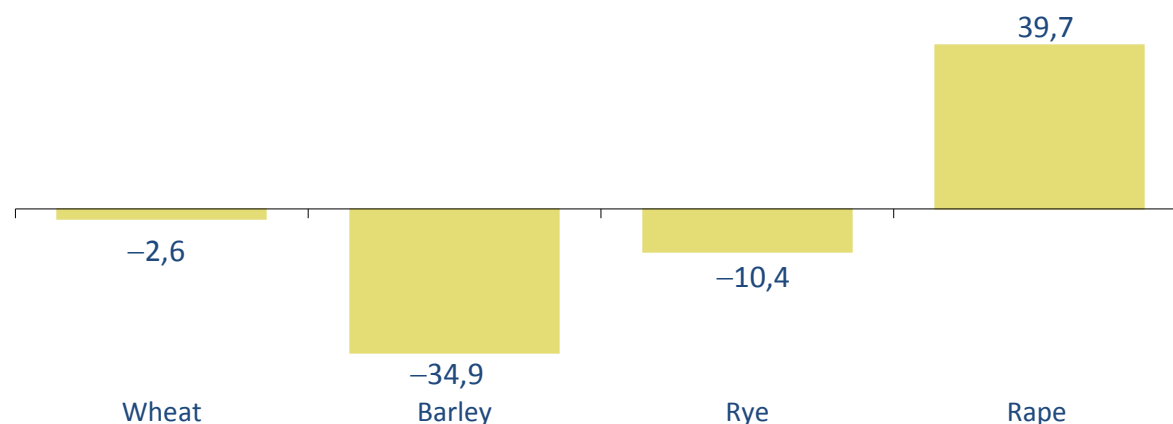

Increase, decrease (–) of sown area of winter crops for grain for the harvest 2022, % (to the area under the harvest 2021)

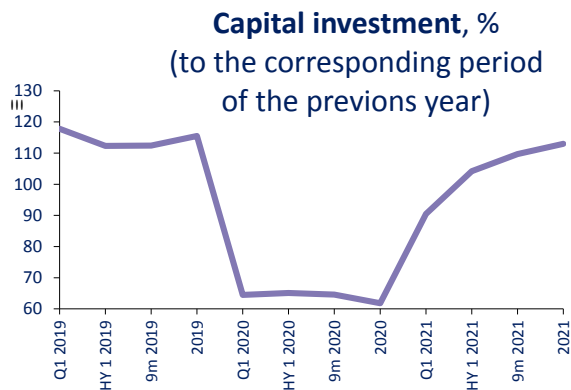

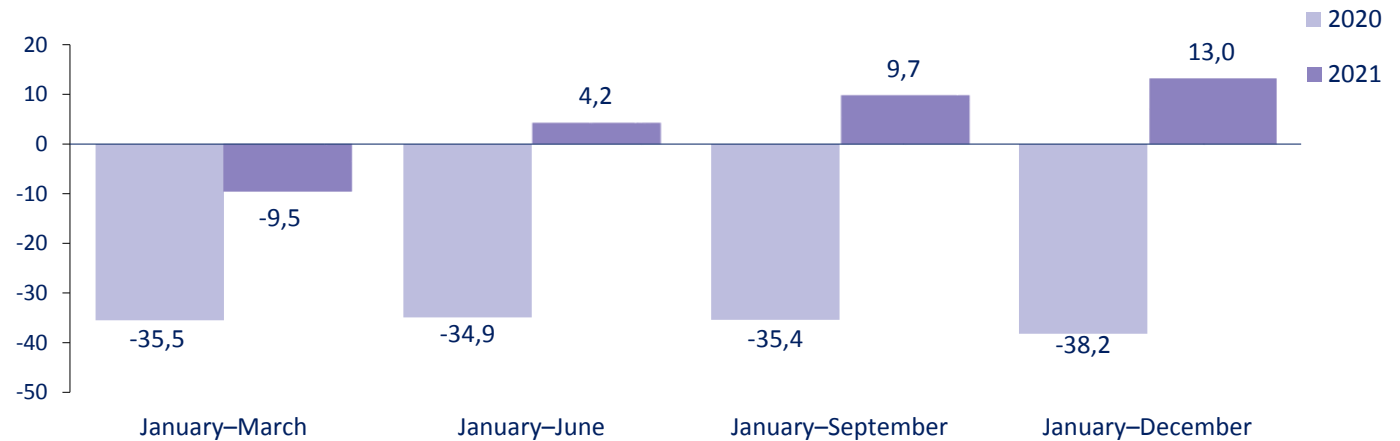

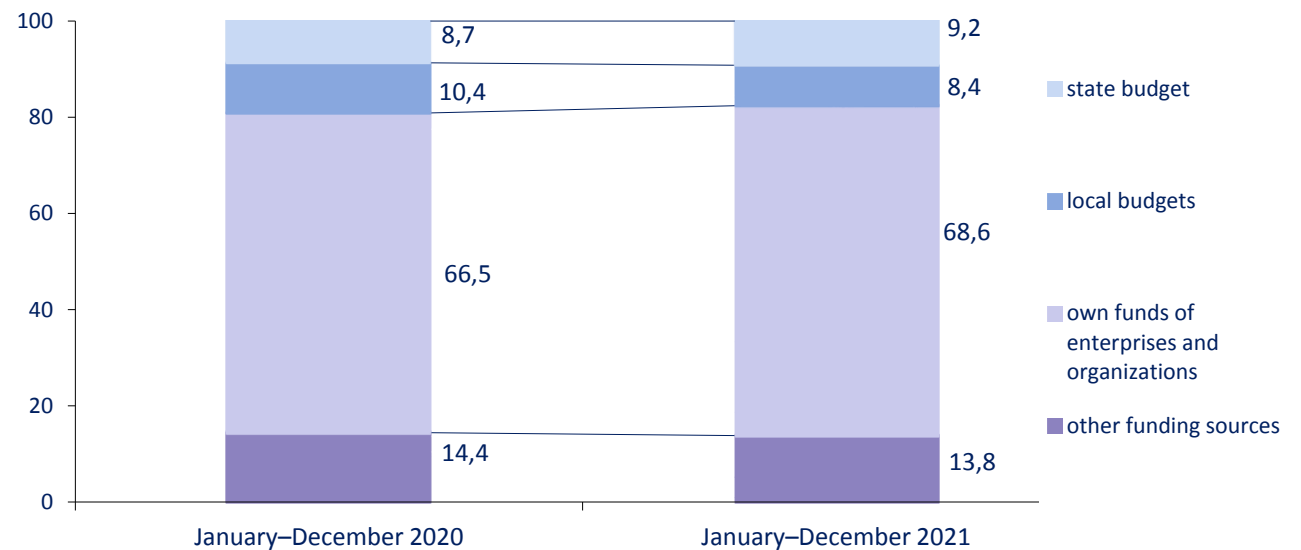

Increase, decrease (-) of the capital investment, % (to the corresponding period of the previous year)



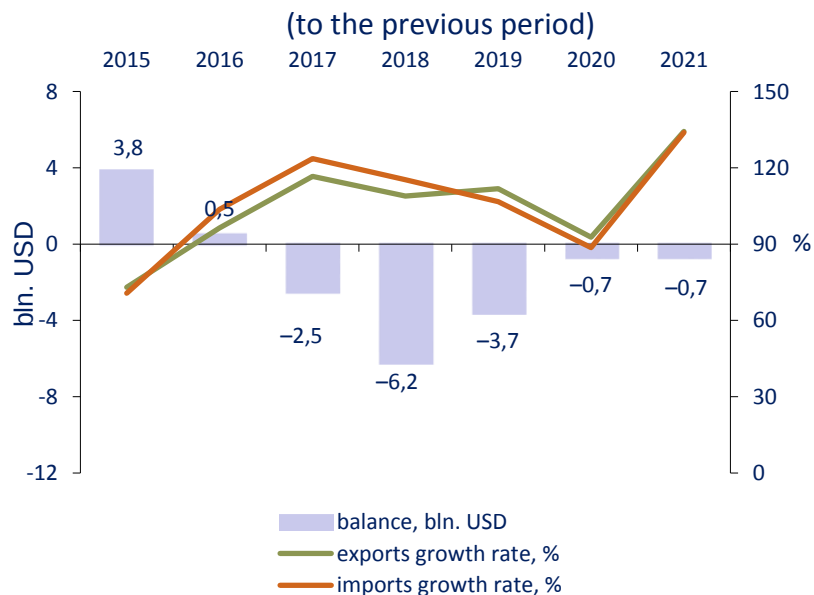
Structure of the capital investment by financing source, % (of total)

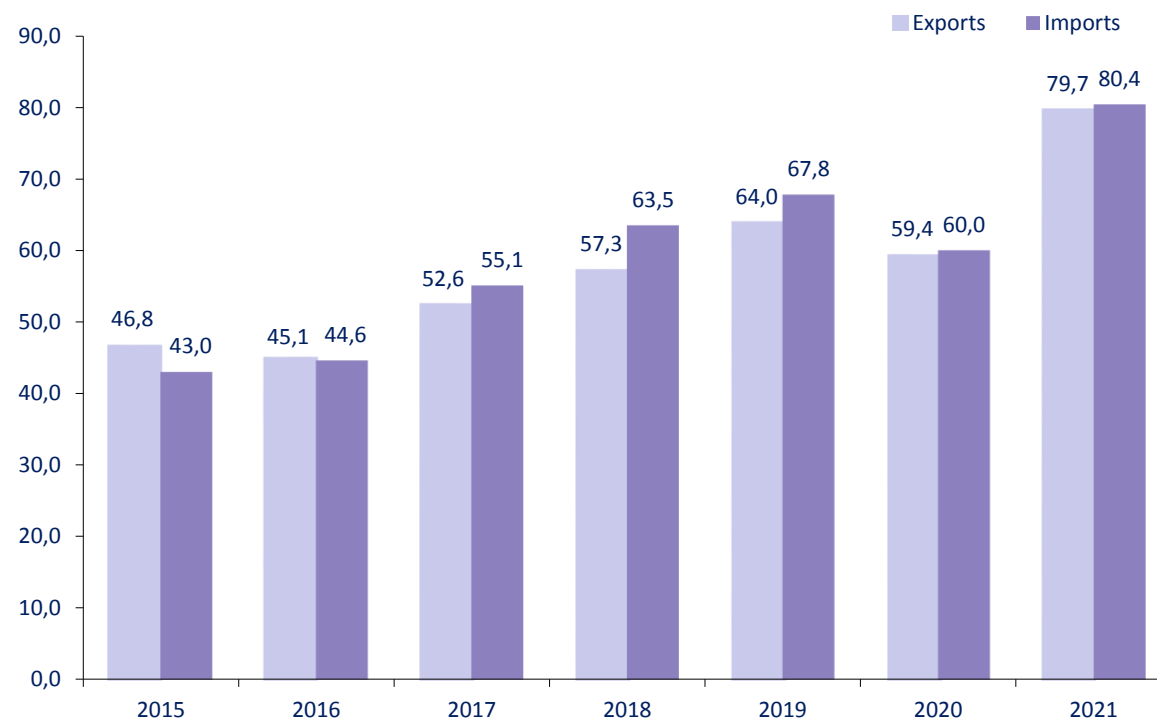

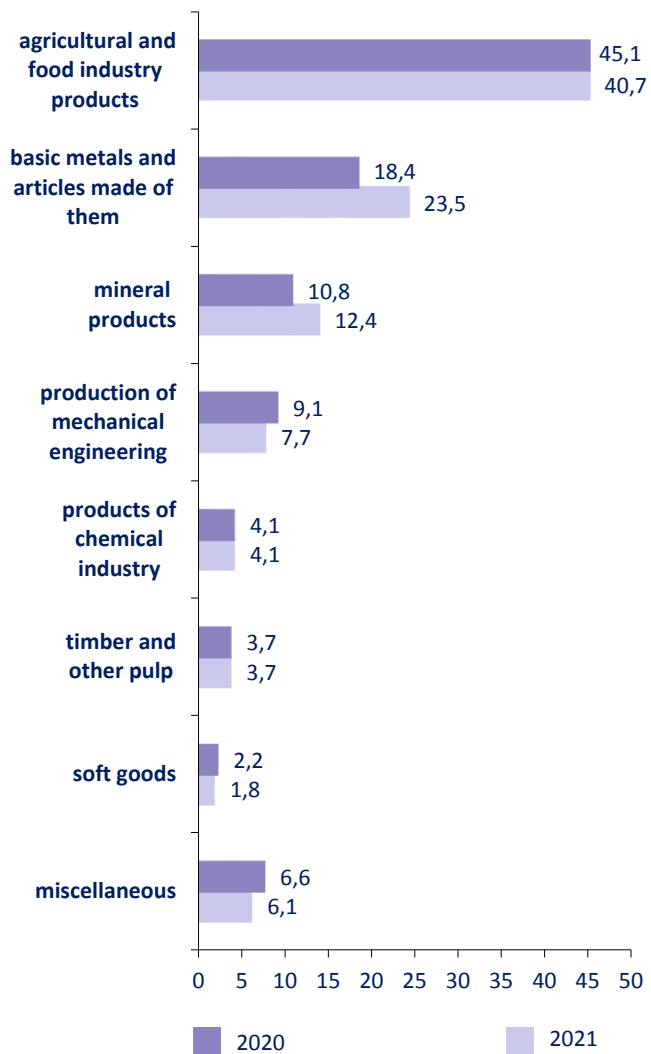

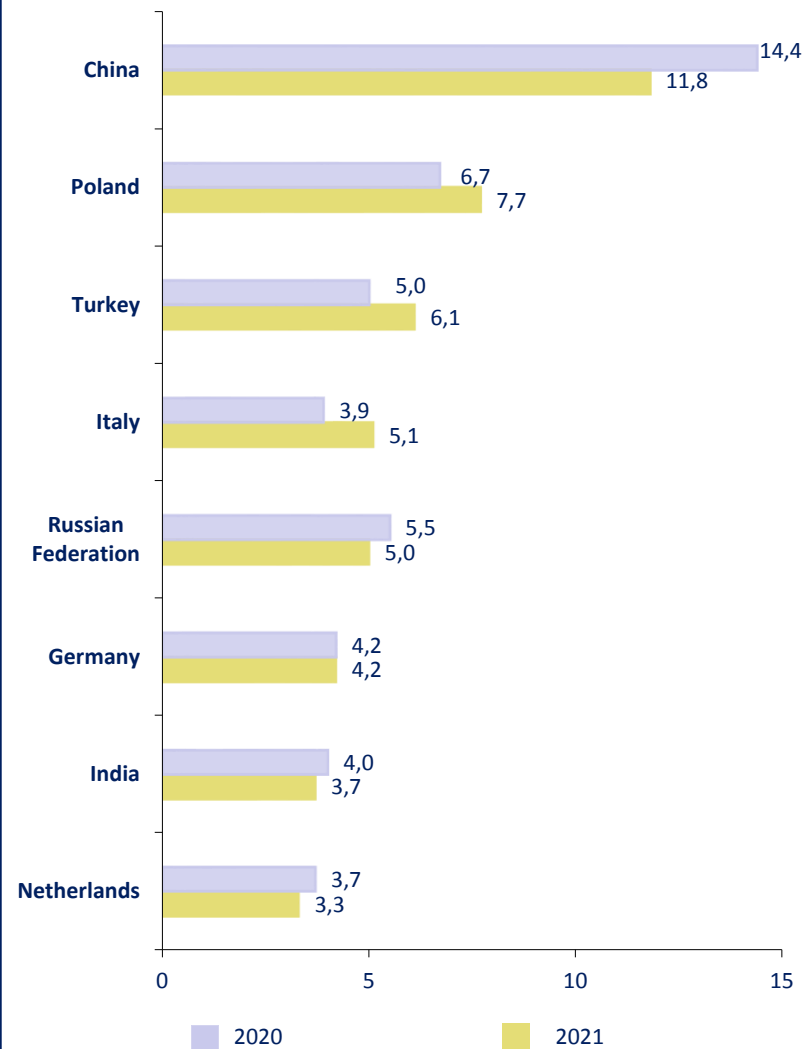
Commodity structure, %

Country structure, %

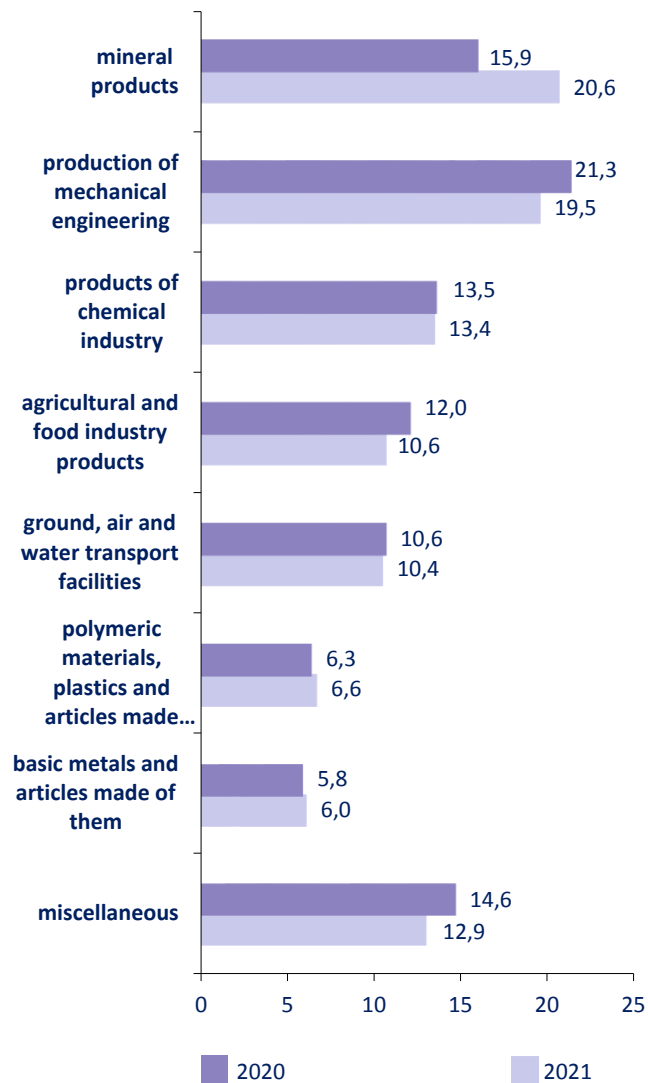

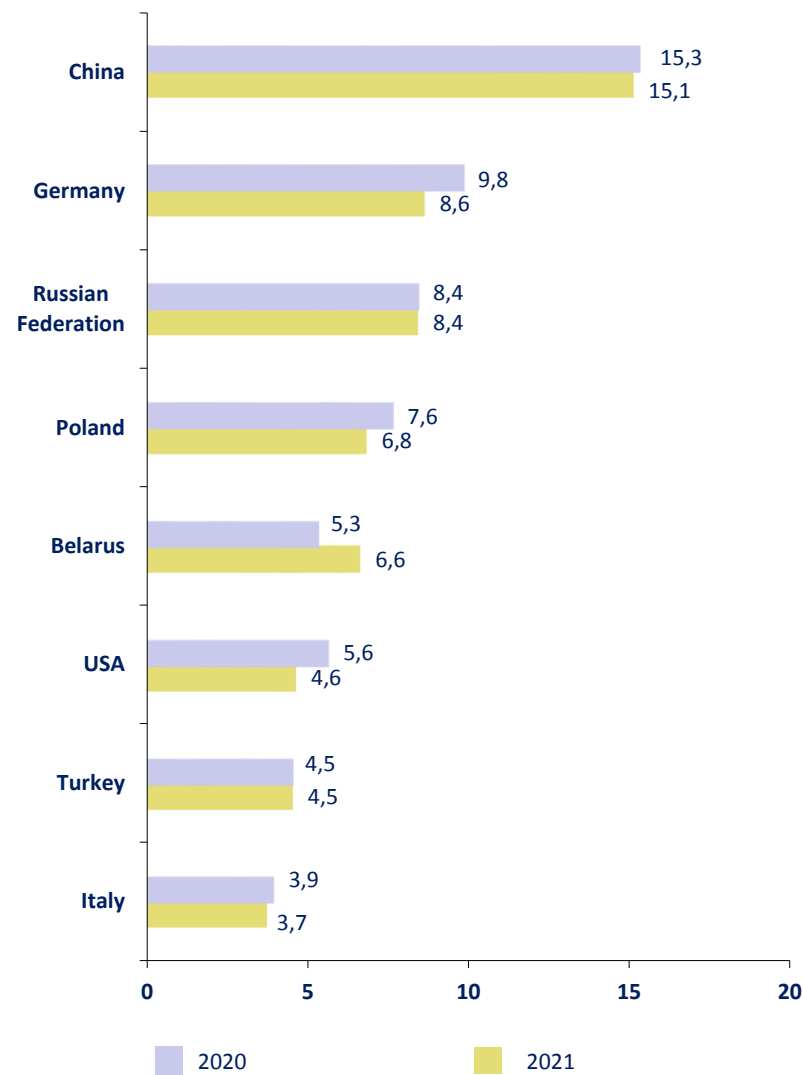

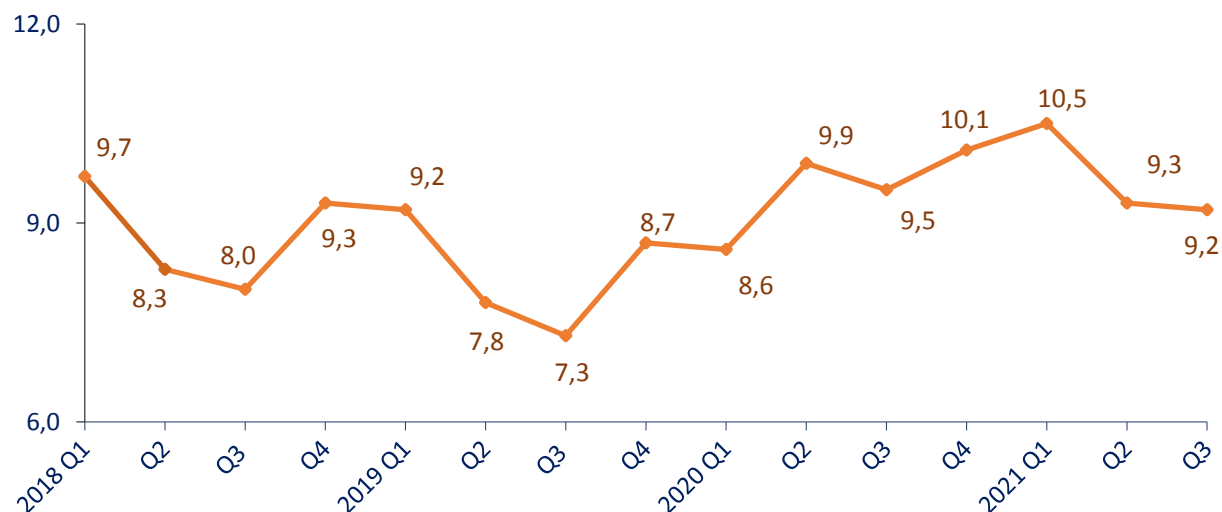

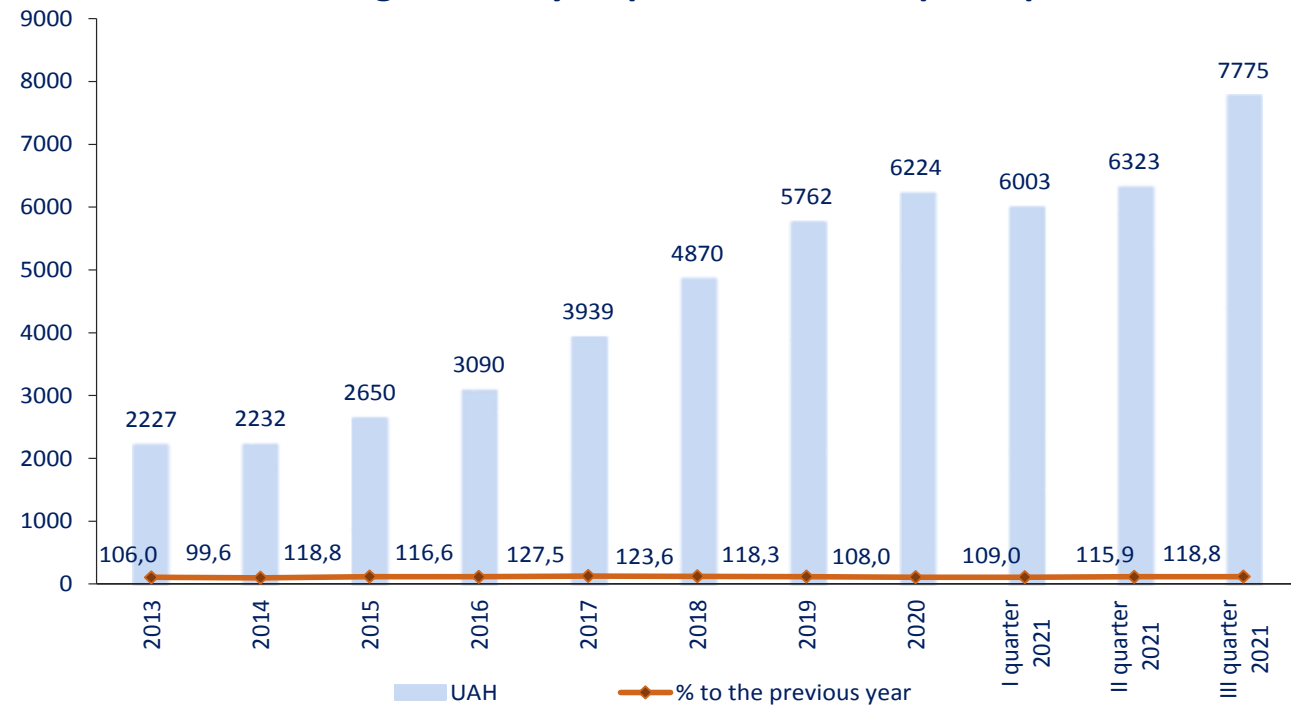

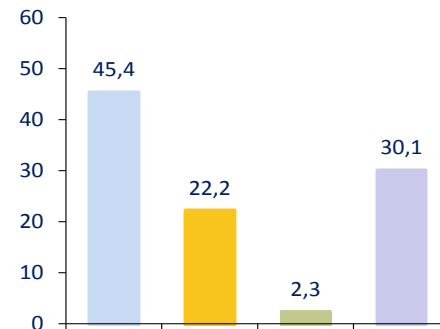
Average monthly disposable income, per capita

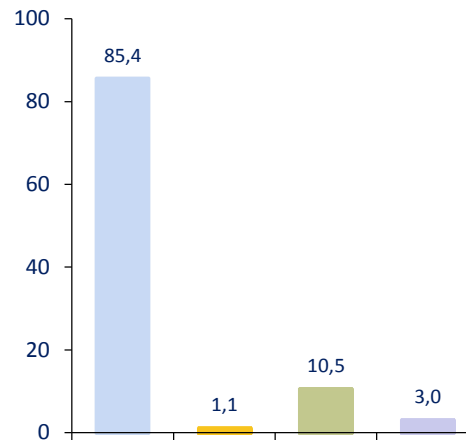

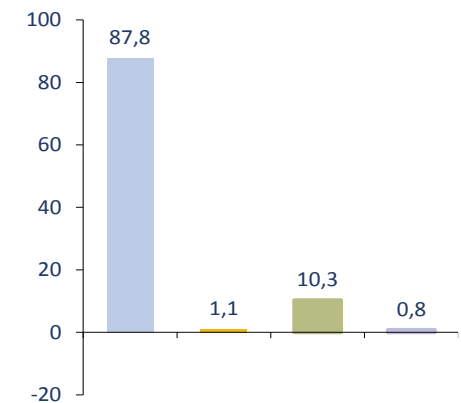

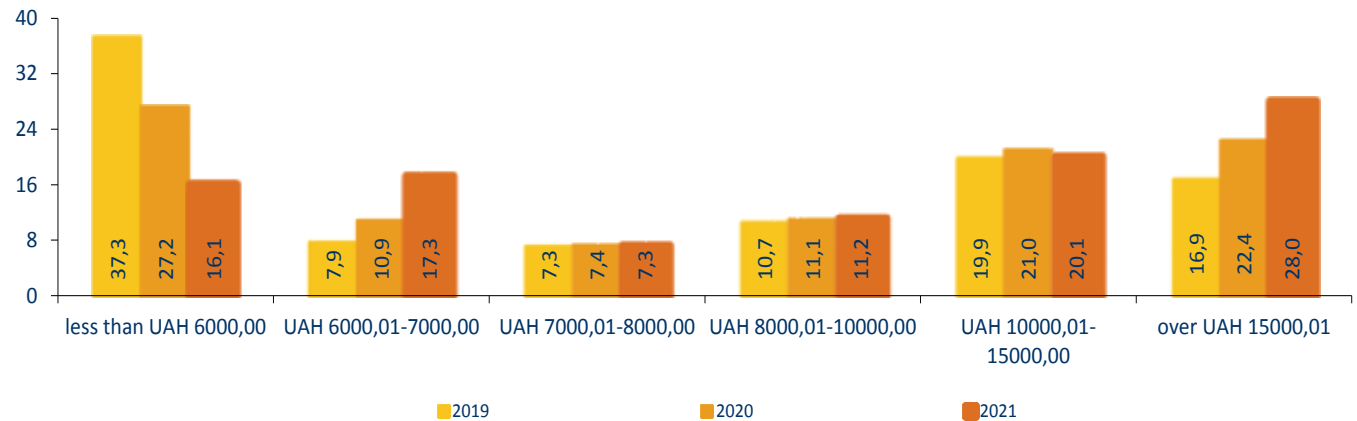

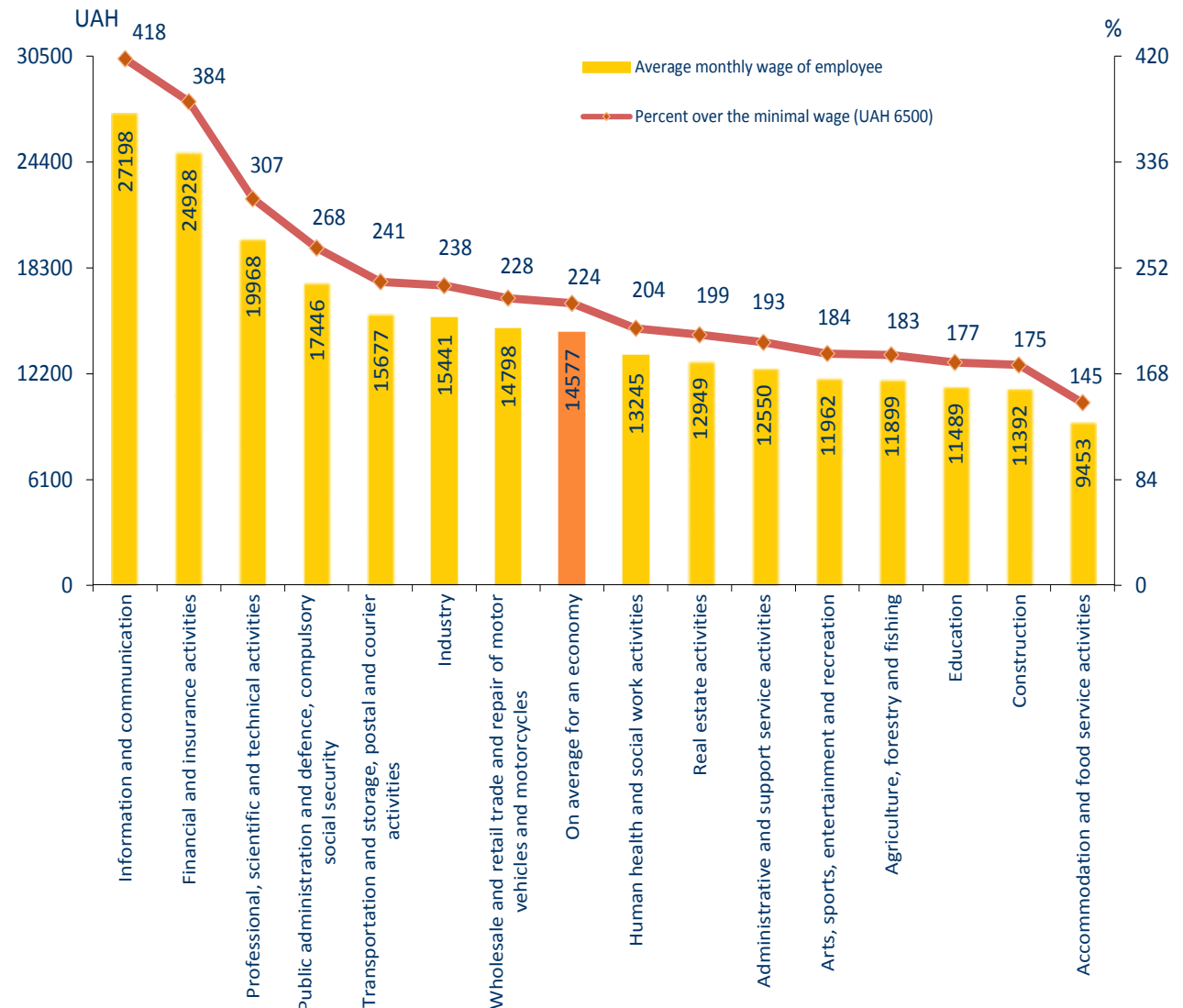


Regular employees by wage level in September 2021, %



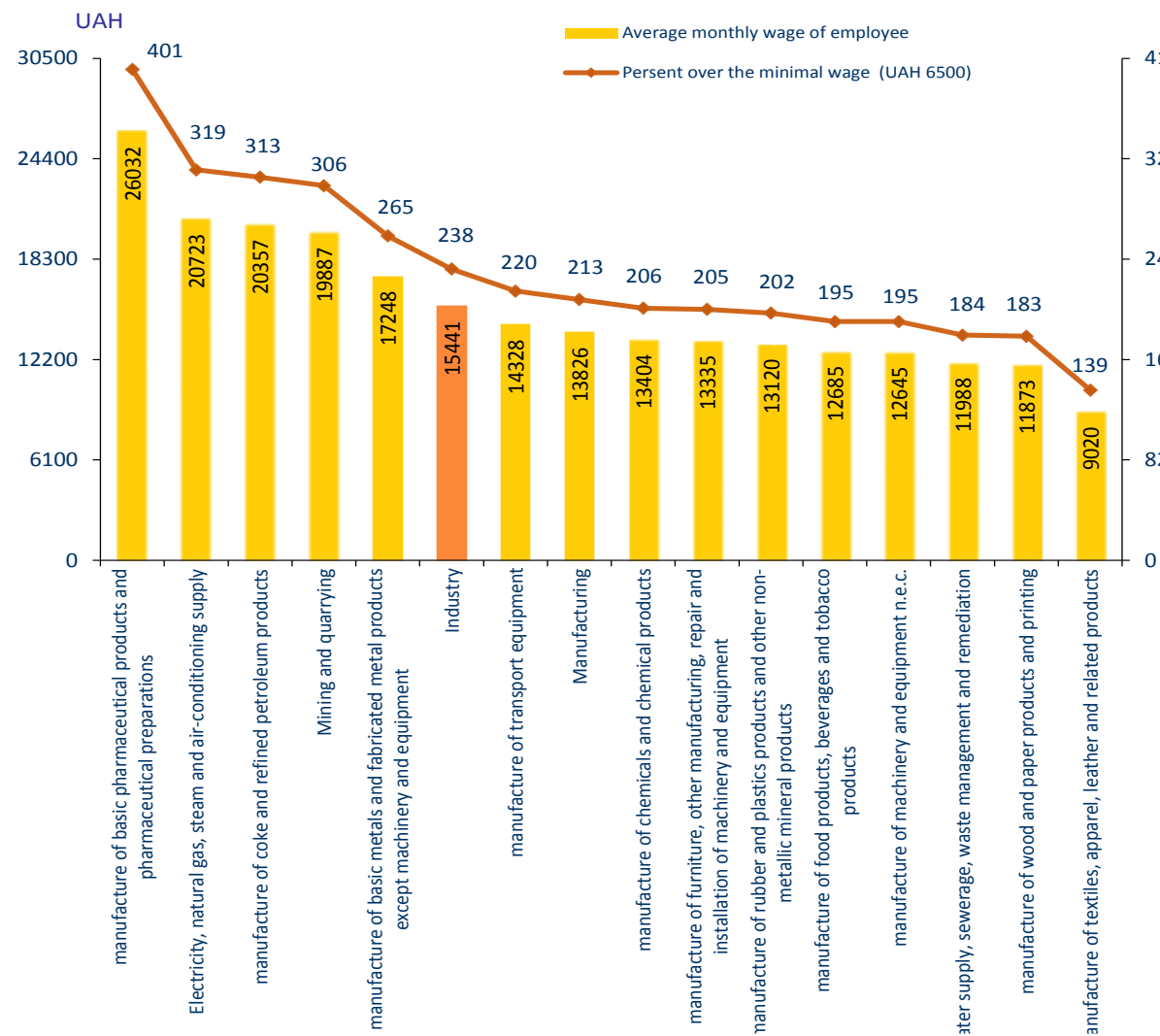

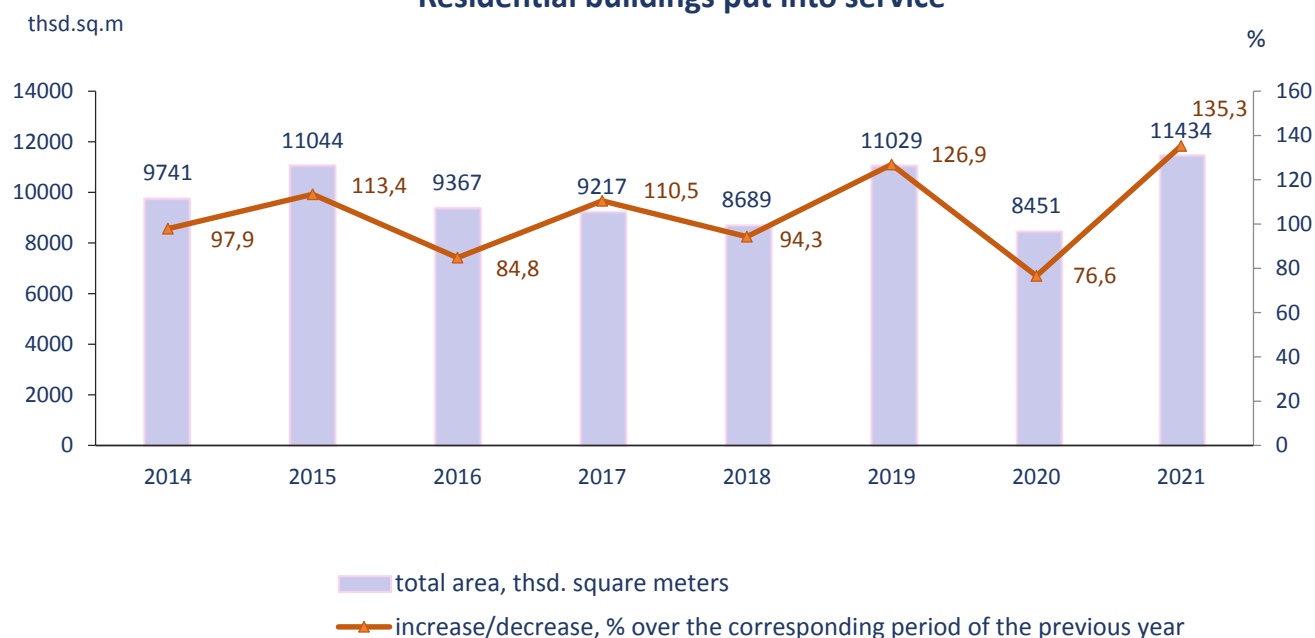

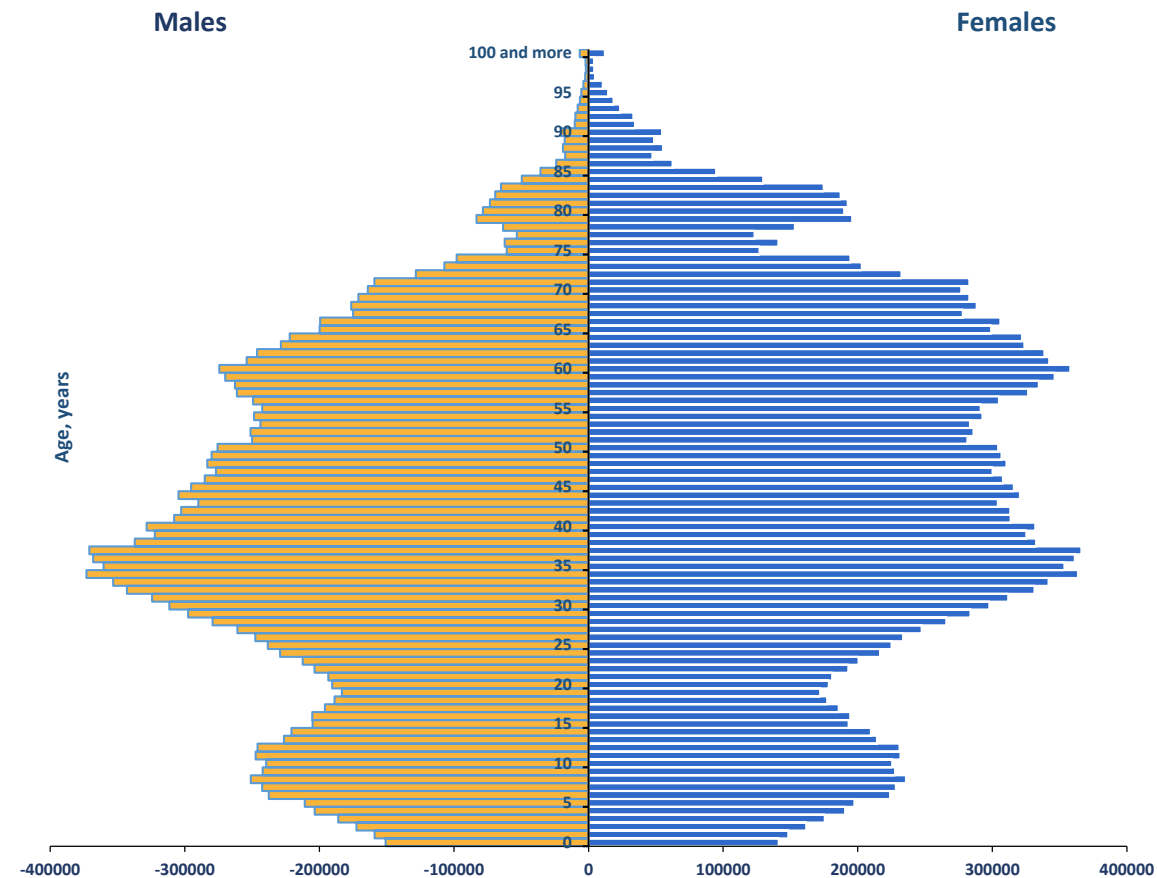
