




**Assessment of current stock of finished products

(seasonal adjustment)**




**Assessment of industrial production  
in the past 3 months**




**Assessment of current export order-books (export demand)

(seasonal adjustment)




**Expected changes in selling prices  
for the products of industry**




### Expected changes in employment at industrial enterprises (seasonal adjustment)




### Factors limitings production (seasonal adjustment)
